The meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Mr. Michael Velker. Mr. Velker stated that the reason the Board exists is to protect the health, welfare, and safety of the people of Tennessee. Ms. Kimberly Hodge conducted a roll call to establish a quorum. A quorum was established. Ms. Hoggard was present to provide interpretation for the applicants that needed assistance.

Approve the minutes from the August 9, 10, and 11, 2021 Board meeting –(2:52)

Dr. Bolden made a motion to approve the August 9, 10, & 11, 2021 minutes, seconded by Mr. Mullins. The motion carried and the minutes were approved.

Applicant Interviews

JuanHong Chen – Thai Foot Massage – (3:12)

Mr. Chen is applying for an Establishment license at 830 N Germantown Pkwy, Unit 104, Cordova, TN. He is a licensed Massage Therapist (LMT 10703) with no prior discipline. He is the owner of six actively licensed Establishments in the Memphis TN area. Mr. Chen is also listed as an employee at each of the Massage Establishments. Mr. Chen omitted some of the Establishments on his original and subsequent applications. Mr. Chen submitted fraudulent Massage Therapist license for the Massage Therapists and Reflexologists listed on the Application including his own.

Dr. Bolden-Greer made a motion seconded by Ms. Yarbrough to move forward in default due to Mr. Chen's absence. Dr. Bolden-Greer made a motion seconded by Mr. Mullins to deny Mr. Chen's establishment application and refer all his establishment over to investigations to have a case opened. The motion carried with a roll call vote.

Fuying Kou – Deferred to November Meeting – (8:26)

Ms. Kou applied for a massage therapist license and was not present at this meeting. A motion was made by Dr. Bolden-Greer, seconded by Ms. Yarbrough to move forward in default. The Board's concerns included that Ms. Kou was practicing massage therapy without a license in March 2019 at Sunshine Massage at 1800 Caruthers Parkway, Suite 6, Brentwood, TN. Sunshine Massage's massage establishment license #4721 was revoked by the Board at their February 10, 2020, meeting, due to the owner, Yuanjie Yang, allowing unlicensed individuals to practice massage at the establishment. Ms. Kou's application review was deferred from the August 2021 Board meeting. After hearing from Mr. Guilford and Ms. Hodge, a motion was made by Mr. Mullins, seconded by Dr. Bolden-Greer, to deny Ms. Kou's application for a massage therapist license, based on incomplete application and due to Ms. Kou practicing massage without a license in an establishment. After hearing further from Mr. Guilford and Ms. Hodge, and some discussion, Ms. Kou arrived at the meeting. Ms. Jiao Hoggard moved in to translate for Ms. Kou. In response to questions from the Board, she stated that she was not, as stated on her application, able to speak, write, read, or understand English fluently. Ms. Kou stated that her massage school had completed the application for her. Mr. Guilford pointed out that the school had not indicated that on the application, as required. The Board heard further from Ms. Kou, particularly about her hypnotist license, which the Board determined did not cover manipulation of soft tissue, which Ms. Kou had been doing. After some discussion, a roll call vote was conducted by Ms. Kim Hodge on the motion by Mr. Mullins, seconded by Dr. Bolden-Greer to deny Ms. Kou's application for a massage therapist license. The motion carried.

JuanHong Chen – Thai Foot Massage – Reopened (35:05)

Mr. Guilford stated that Mr. JuanHong Chen had arrived at the Board meeting. A motion was made by Dr. Bolden-Greer, seconded by Ms. Yarbrough, to reopen JuanHong Chen's application. A roll call vote was conducted by Ms. Hodge. The motion carried. Mr. Chen stated that he changed the dates on the certificates at the post office because the expiration dates were expired. Mr. Guilford then pointed out that some of the corrected dates had been typed and therefore, were changed before he went to the post office to mail in the application packet. After hearing from Mr. Chen, and after a brief discussion, a motion was made by Dr. Bolden-Greer, seconded by Ms. Burke, to deny the application based on incomplete application and fraud in the application, and to refer this matter to Investigations. A roll call vote was conducted by Ms. Hodge. The motion carried.

Ying Chen – (42:03)

Ms. Chen had applied for a massage therapist license and was willing to be present at the August 9, 2021, meeting by phone call. The Board deferred her application to allow her to be present at the November meeting to answer questions. The Board's concerns included that Ms. Chen

completed her massage education at American & European Massage Clinic, Inc. in Raleigh, NC. This school's approval has been revoked by the North Carolina Board of Massage and Bodywork Therapy due to violations of their Practice Act (see NC board order). Ms. Chen was not present at the meeting. Dr. Bolden-Greer made a motion, seconded by Mr. Mullins to proceed in default. A roll call vote was conducted by Ms. Hodge, and the motion carried. After a brief discussion, Dr. Bolden-Greer made a motion to deny the application based upon inadequate education. Ms. Yarbrough seconded the motion, and a roll call vote was conducted. The motion carried.

Zhenhua Su – (45:10)

Ms. Su applied for a massage therapist license and was present at this meeting. The Board's concerns include that Ms. Su signed up to take the 11/12/2020 5-hour Tennessee massage law class at Mind Body Institute in Madison, TN. The instructor, Ms. Maj-Lis Nash, stated in an email to the Board's administrative office that due to technical issues and a language barrier, Ms. Su was unable to complete the class. In addition, Ms. Nash stated that she was unsure that the person taking the class was Ms. Su, due to the log-in being used. The administrative office discovered that the email used in that log-in belonged to Xiao Zhou, TN LMT#10629. Ms. Nash offered Ms. Su an opportunity to re-take the class in December at no additional charge, but Ms. Su chose to take a 5-hour Tennessee massage law class on 12/17/2020 at Tennessee School of Therapeutic Massage. The Board heard from Ms. Su, Ms. Hodge, Mr. Guilford, and Ms. Maj-Li Nash. After much discussion, a motion was made by Dr. Bolden-Greer, seconded by Mr. Mullins, to defer Ms. Su's application to the next Board meeting to allow time for the administrative office to reach out to the school to confirm Ms. Su's attendance. Also, to confirm that Ms. Su had passed the class; passed any required tests, and that Ms. Su had a good understanding of the subject matter. A friendly amendment to this motion was offered by Mr. Mullins, seconded by Ms. Yarbrough, to allow Ms. Su's application to be administratively approved upon successful review of the documentation from the school by the Board's consultant. A roll call vote was conducted by Ms. Hodge. The amended motion carried.

The Board took a brief break. When the Board reconvened, a roll call was conducted by Ms. Hodge. All Board members had returned, and a quorum was re-established.

Xiaoyan Wang – (1:35:07)

Ms. Wang applied for a massage therapist license and was not present at this meeting. A motion was made by Mr. Mullins, seconded by Ms. Vickers, to proceed in default. A roll call vote was conducted by Ms. Hodge. The motion carried. The Board's concerns included that Ms. Wang completed her massage education at American & European Massage Clinic, Inc., in North Carolina. This school's approval has been revoked by North Carolina. At the August 11, 2021, Board meeting, the Board voted to defer Ms. Wang's application review to the November 8, 2021, meeting at Ms. Wang's request. A motion was made by Mr. Mullins, seconded by Dr. Bolden-Greer, to deny Ms. Wang's application for a massage therapist license based on inadequate education. A roll call vote was conducted by Ms. Hodge. The motion carried.

YuanYuan Wang - (1:37:45)

Ms. Wang applied for a massage therapist license and was present at this meeting. The Board's concerns included that Ms. Wang's previous application was denied by the Board at its November 2017 meeting, based on evidence that her MBLEx score had been invalidated by the FSMTB as a result of Ms. Wang providing inaccurate educational information on her MBLEx application, and not having the required education prior to taking the MBLEx. Ms. Wang did not provide a completed application in 2017 as a result of her score being invalidated. Ms. Wang has now passed the MBLEx a second time. The Board heard from Ms. Wang. A motion was made by Ms. Yarbrough, seconded by Ms. Vickers, to approve Ms. Wang's application. A roll call vote was conducted by Ms. Hodge. The motion carried.

Hao Wu – (1:40:15)

Mr. Wu applied for a massage therapist license and was present at this meeting. The Board's concerns included that Mr. Wu graduated from Phoenix International School of Massage in Houston, TX. All of Mr. Wu's hours, except for the 55 hours of Internship, were completed online. The Board heard from Mr. Wu, Mr. Guilford, and Ms. Hodge. After much discussion, a motion was made by Dr. Bolden-Greer, seconded by Ms. Yarbrough, to allow Mr. Wu to withdraw his application. A roll call vote was conducted by Ms. Hodge. The motion carried.

Shu Ling Yang – (1:57:00)

Ms. Yang applied for a massage therapist license and was present at this meeting. This Board denied Ms. Yang's previous application on June 7, 2017, based on Ms. Yang's failure to complete a Board approved and THEC approved massage education program. In 2017, Ms. Yang had completed her education at Brightness Massage School for the Blind ("Brightness") in Memphis, TN, which had lost its THEC approval. In her current application, Ms. Yang has transcripts submitted from THEC about her education at Brightness, as well as two different transcripts from Greater DFW International Massage Academy ("DFW") in Plano, TX. The DFW transcript received on June 14, 2021, shows that all of Ms. Yang's hours, except for the 50 hour Internship, were completed online. The DFW transcript received on July 12, 2021, showed that all Ms. Yang's hours were completed in-classroom. A motion was made by Dr. Bolden-Greer, seconded by Ms. Yarbrough, to defer Ms. Yang's application to the next Board meeting to allow the administrative office to reach out to DFW to get a letter of explanation of why our office has received the two different transcripts. After hearing from Ms. Yang, Mr. Guilford, and Ms. Hodge, the Board proceeded with discussion. Ms. Hodge requested that Ms. Yang also submit documentation showing that she was in Texas at the time she completed her education at DFW. A roll call vote was conducted by Ms. Hodge. The motion carried.

Hua You – (2:11:28)

Ms. You applied for a massage therapist license and was not present at this meeting. Ms. You sent an e-mail to the Administrative Office from the Footy Rooty Institute e-mail address stating she wouldn't be able to be present for the meeting. Mr. Mullins made a motion, seconded by Ms. Yarbrough to proceed in default. A roll call vote was conducted by Ms. Hodge, and the motion carried. Ms. You graduated from Footy Rooty Institute in Houston, TX. This school was under a

Cease-and-Desist order from Texas due to educational and exam concerns, and the administrative office has received additional information indicating that in-person attendance is not required. Mr. Guilford briefly discussed the cease-and desist order from Texas. Dr. Bolden-Greer made a motion, seconded by Ms. Yarbrough to defer the application to the February 9, 2022. The motion failed. Mr. Mullins read sections of the cease-and desist letter regarding the Texas Board's concern of the school providing answers to the MBLEx exam to the students. After additional discussion, Dr. Bolden-Greer withdrew his motion to defer. Mr. Mullins stated that Ms. You was also deficient 15 hours of science. With that, Mr. Mullins made a motion, seconded by Dr. Bolden-Greer, to deny Ms. You's application due to inadequate education. A roll call vote was conducted by Ms. Hodge, and the motion carried.

DongYan Liu – Asian Massage – (2:22:05)

Ms. Liu applied for an initial massage establishment license at 1503 B Fort Campbell Blvd, Clarksville TN. Ms. Liu was not a licensed massage therapist in TN, but has a massage establishment in Pennsylvania, which was where her home address was listed. Ms. Liu states that "she has hired a manager for her business in PA and will come to TN and oversee her shop until her business grows and she can hire a manager." Ms. Xiaoru Duan was the massage therapist listed on the application and was also the previous establishment license owner at this location. Online reviews listed on Google 2 days prior to receiving the application showed a review of the establishment posted by "Dongyan Liu." Mr. Guilford informed the Board that a week prior to the Board meeting, and investigator visited Asian Massage and found Ms. Liu and two unlicensed therapists working in the business. Ms. Liu stated that she gained ownership of the business in July 2021, but that Ms. Duan promised not to retire her establishment license until Ms. Liu was granted her establishment license. Ms. Liu then stated that Ms. Duan retired her license in August without informing Liu. Ms. Liu also stated that the two unlicensed therapist were previous employees of Ms. Duan. The Board heard from Ms. Liu, Ms. Hodge, Mr. Guilford, and Mr. Charles West, LMT and Board-approved continuing education provider. A motion was made by Dr. Bolden-Greer, seconded by Mr. Mullins, to deny Ms. Liu's application for a massage establishment license based upon 63-18-108(1)(6)(7)(9). A roll call vote was conducted by Ms. French. The motion carried.

Xiaoru Duan, LMT #10456 – Asian Massage Establishment – (2:29:30)

Ms. Duan applied for reactivation of her massage establishment license #4059 at 1503 B Fort Campbell Blvd, Clarksville TN, and was not present at this meeting. Ms. Duan held the establishment license from June 2014 until she retired it in August 2021. Ms. Duan is a massage therapist with no prior discipline on her massage therapist license. Ms. Duan sent an e-mail to the Board Administrative Office upon receiving her invitation to the Board meeting, stating that she had sold the business to Ms. Dongyan Liu. There is currently an open investigation on this establishment by the Office of Investigations for opening and operating without a current establishment license. A motion was made by Dr. Bolden-Greer, seconded by Ms. Yarbrough, to deny Ms. Duan's reactivation application. A roll call vote was conducted by Ms. Hodge. The motion carried.

The Board took a lunch break. When they reconvened, a roll call was conducted by Ms. Hodge. All Board members had returned, and a quorum was re-established.

Xiaojing Han – Foot Massage – (4:39:15)

Ms. Han is a TN licensed massage therapist that has applied for an establishment license located at 940 Parkway, Sevierville, TN. A previous application for the same location from Mr. Donghai Liu, LMT 12819, was denied by the Board at their February 2021 meeting. Mr. Liu was also denied an establishment license for Kozy Massage in August 2020, where Ms. Han was listed as a reflexologist employee on Mr. Liu's denied application. The Board wanted to ensure that Ms. Han was going to truly own and operate the business and wasn't applying for the establishment license for Mr. Liu. Ms. Han was present at meeting, and stated she now holds the lease for this location. After a brief discussion, Ms. Vickers made a motion, seconded by Dr. Bolden-Greer to approve Ms. Han's establishment application. A roll call vote was conducted by Ms. Hodge, and the motion carried.

Julie Sienberg, LMT #12946 – Fit 10 – (4:50:56)

Ms. Sienberg applied for an establishment license at 2121 N Jackson St, Tullahoma TN, and was present at the meeting. She has held a TN massage therapist license since May 2019 and has no previous discipline. Online advertising on Facebook shows that the establishment was open and offering massage services at the time of application. Facebook posts reflect that Ms. Sienberg first began booking appointments as of October 2020. Ms. Sienberg admitted that she moved to the location after working under a Chiropractor and forgot that she needed an Establishment license to practice at the new location. Ms. Sienberg has ceased practicing at the address since she received communication from the administrative office. After a brief discussion, Dr. Bolden-Greer made a motion, seconded by Ms. Vickers to approve a conditional license with civil penalties totaling \$2,500.00 paid within 90 days. A roll call vote was conducted by Ms. Hodge, and the motion carried.

Erin Talley, LMT #4794 – Omni Nashville LLC dba Mokara Spa – (4:56:40)

Ms. Talley applied to become the responsible person for the establishment license for Omni Nashville LLC dba Mokara Spa located at 250 5th Ave. S, Nashville, TN, and was present at this meeting. Ms. Talley has been licensed as a TN massage therapist since December 2004 with no prior discipline. The Board's concerns included that Ms. Talley's criminal background check revealed a DUI on 06-20-2020. Based upon the Board's current policy and consultation of the Board Director and Board Attorney, Ms. Talley was sent to TnPAP for an evaluation. Based upon the recommendations of the evaluation, the Board had questions for Ms. Teresa Phillips from TnPAP. After a detailed question and answer with Ms. Phillips, the Board heard from Mr. Steve Sommers who supported Ms. Phillips explanation regarding how a mild alcohol use disorder is defined and the usual treatment associated with the diagnosis. Ms. Wells Trompeter, Omni legal counsel, was present with Ms. Talley. The Board heard from Ms. Talley, who stated that she is currently on probation until December 2021 and has received random drug test over the past year of probation. Ms. Talley stated that she had passed all drug test that she was required to take while

on probation. Ms. Talley also informed the Board that she had started her therapy sessions per TnPAP's treatment recommendations.

The Board took a brief break. When the Board reconvened, a roll call was conducted by Ms. Hodge. All Board members had returned, and a quorum was re-established.

After additional discussion, the Board considered the Fresh Start Act as it applied to this application. A motion was made by Dr. Bolden-Greer, seconded by Ms. Vickers, to approve a conditional massage establishment license, conditioned upon Ms. Talley obtaining and maintaining TnPAP advocacy. After some discussion, and hearing further from Mr. Guilford, Ms. Hodge, and Ms. Talley, a roll call vote was conducted by Ms. French, and the motion carried.

Kenny Bailey – The Recovery Lounge – (5:42:27)

Mr. Bailey applied for an establishment license located at 320 Liberty Pike, Suite 125, Franklin TN 37064, and was present at this meeting. Mr. Bailey is not a massage therapist. The Board's concerns included Mr. Bailey's explanation that he submitted with his initial application that the establishment was open and operating prior to application submission due to Mr. Bailey being unaware that a license was needed when massage services were added to his business. Facebook reflected massage reviews on June 6, 2021, and the business website allowed for appointments to be booked on the date the application was received in the administrative office and in the following weeks proceeding receipt of the application. The Board heard from Mr. Bailey who stated massage services began to be offered in October 2020 up and until an investigator visited one of the therapists employed at The Recovery Lounge. After some discussion, a motion was made by Dr. Bolden-Greer, seconded by Ms. Yarbrough, to approve a conditional license for Mr. Bailey's establishment application conditioned upon his payment of civil penalties totaling \$800.00 within 30 days. A roll call vote was conducted by Ms. Hodge, and the motion carried.

Jasmine Miller – Elite Multitude Services LLC dba The Wax House – (5:54:06)

Before the interview began, Ms. Vickers put on record that she provided Ms. Miller's 2-hour TN Law class but stated that she had no conflict in hearing and making a decision on Ms. Miller's establishment license application. Ms. Miller applied for an establishment license at 2237 Lowes Drive, Suite G, Clarksville, TN, and was present at this meeting. Ms. Miller was not a massage therapist. The Board's concerns included that Ms. Miller stated "no" on the application to the establishment being opened prior to application, but posts on Facebook and online reviews on Yelp and Google reflect massage offered as early as May 30, 2021, and as recently as October 11, 2021. The website for the business shows various massage services but no longer allows booking of those services. On October 9, 2021, an administrative staff member was able to book services, but after staff contacted owner and made her aware that an establishment license was needed, the ability to book massages was removed. The Board heard from Ms. Miller, Ms. Hodge, and Mr. Guilford. After a discussion, a motion was made by Mr. Mullins, seconded by Dr. Bolden-Greer, to approve Ms. Miller's application for a massage establishment license conditioned upon Ms. Miller paying civil penalties totaling \$900.00 within 30 days. A roll call vote was conducted by Ms. Hodge, and the motion carried.

Elvis Griggs – iKnead Massage Therapy, LLC (6:12:15)

Mr. Mullins recused himself from this applicant interview, since he personally knows Mr. Griggs. Mr. Griggs is applying for reactivation of his establishment license (ME 4179) located at 1321 Murfreesboro Pike, Nashville, TN. He is a licensed Massage Therapist (LMT 9392) with no prior discipline on his therapist license. Mr. Griggs does have prior discipline on his establishment license from 2015 when he received a conditional license due to prior convictions and peer assistance recommendations. Mr. Griggs did not mark that he had received the discipline when he submitted his original establishment reactivation application. The establishment license expired on January 31, 2017. Mr. Griggs renewal application was received in the administrative office on/around March 10, 2017, and a deficiency letter was sent to inform Mr. Griggs that reactivation of the license was required due to the license being expired. No additional documentation was submitted by Mr. Griggs until his establishment reactivation application was received on October 27, 2021. According to online reviews and advertisements, the business had been open and operating at the Establishment address since June 2019. Mr. Griggs was present and stated that he never received the deficiency letter stating that his license had and expired, and he would need to reactivate his establishment license. He also stated that he has only been offering outcalls since 2019, when he thought his establishment license expired, but he has continued to advertise for massage services at his establishment location. He further stated that he did give massages to his friends at the establishment in return for them to post reviews, which is a form of compensation. After much discussion, a motion was made by Dr. Bolden-Greer, seconded by Ms. Yarbrough, to approve Mr. Griggs' application for to reinstate his massage establishment license conditioned upon payment of civil penalties totaling \$2,500.00 within 24 months. After more discussion, a roll call vote was conducted by Ms. Hodge, and the motion carried.

Cristi Elizabeth Adams – (6:58:00)

Ms. Adams applied for a massage therapist license and was present at this meeting. The Board's concerns included that Ms. Adams' massage school, Academy of Somatic Arts in Atlanta, GA, closed. The transcript the administrative office received from the Georgia Nonpublic Postsecondary Education Commission showed that Ms. Adams completed only 8 months of the curriculum and showed that half of her classes on the transcript were "still in process". This transcript shows grades for completed classes, but no information on how many hours Ms. Adams actually completed. At Ms. Adams' request, the State of Georgia has also sent copies of certificates showing some courses completed, but still no information on how many hours she completed. Since Ms. Adams was licensed as a massage therapist in Georgia, the administrative office reached out to that licensure board, and received confirmation from them that Ms. Adams was grandfathered into licensure in Georgia and was not required to provide any proof of education. Upon review by the Board's educational and legal consultants, Ms. Adams's application was referred for the Board's review. The Board heard from Ms. Adams, Mr. Guilford, Ms. Hodge, and Ms. Maj-Lis Nash of Mind Body Institute. A motion was made by Dr. Bolden-Greer, seconded by Ms. Yarbrough, to defer Ms. Adams' application to the next Board meeting to

allow Ms. Adams to rectify her educational deficiencies through an approved massage school. A roll call vote was conducted by Ms. Hodge, and the motion carried.

Cindy Rance Boles – (7:32:40)

Ms. Boles applied for a massage therapist license and was present at this meeting. The Board's concerns include that Ms. Boles had multiple criminal convictions, the most recent of which is dated September 2013. Ms. Boles' Licensed Practical Nurse license was voluntarily surrendered by a consent order of the Tennessee Board of Nursing, as a result of that board's finding that Ms. Boles was "guilty of unprofessional conduct, to wit: intentionally or negligently causing a physical or emotional injury to a patient". Ms. Boles has also been placed on the Tennessee Department of Health Abuse Registry, and on the U.S. government Office of Inspector General List of Excluded Individuals, which excludes Ms. Boles from receiving payment from Federal healthcare programs for any items or services. The Board heard from Ms. Boles and Mr. Guilford. The Board voiced concerns of Ms. Boles practicing as a solo practitioner and discussed if she needed to work under supervision in order to have support. Mr. Guilford discussed in detail with the Board the process of monitoring supervision and the some of the issues that have been found in the past. After additional discussion Dr. Bolden-Greer made a motion, seconded by Ms. Yarbrough to approve Ms. Boles application without conditions contingent upon her correcting her application regarding understanding the Board's rules. A roll call vote was conducted by Ms. Hodge, and the motion carried.

Matthew Kalman Kirsch (7:58:45)

Mr. Kirsch applied for a massage therapist license and was present at this meeting. The Board's concerns include that Mr. Kirsch's transcript from A New Beginning School of Massage in Austin, TX, shows that Mr. Kirsch only completed 245 hours at the school. Additional documentation received from the school shows the same hours on the transcript; a graduation date of 7/5/2013; and a statement that Mr. Kirsch completed 245 hours at their school. However, the letter goes on to state that the school operates a 500-hour program. The Board office also received a transcript showing Mr. Kirsch completed an acupuncture education program, which due to the Board's Rules cannot be considered. Upon consultation with the Board educational and legal consultants, the administration office was unable to approve Mr. Kirsch's application. Mr. Kirsch requested that the Board review his application. After a detailed discussion by the Board, and hearing from Mr. Kirsch, the Board informed Mr. Kirsch that they don't have any discretion in deviating from the Board rules and statutes regarding the education requirements. Ms. Vickers made a motion, seconded by Dr. Bolden-Greer to defer Mr. Kirsch application to the February Board meeting to allow him the opportunity to contact his school and TX and have an official transcript submitted that reflects he completed a 500-hour massage program. A roll call vote was conducted by Ms. Hodge, and the motion carried.

Brandon L. Woods (8:31:42)

Mr. Woods applied for a massage therapist license and was present at this meeting. The Board's concerns included that Mr. Woods' previous application was denied by the Board on August 8,

2016, based upon Mr. Woods' criminal convictions and his refusal to comply with the recommendations of the evaluation he obtained through the Board's impaired practitioner program. At the time, he indicated he was moving to Kansas. On his current application, Mr. Woods marked "no" to question 6 on page 5 of the application, indicating that he has never applied for a license that was denied. His letter of recommendation from Laura Krieger of Fullerton, California, indicates that he has been working as a massage therapist, however Mr. Woods stated on his application that he does not hold a massage therapist license in any state, but verified he worked in Kansas where licensure isn't required. Mr. Guilford informed the Board that Mr. Woods public intoxication was 11 years ago, so Mr. Woods no longer would be required to obtain a TnPAP evaluation. Rather Mr. Woods was called before the Board because his 2016 application was denied, and all denials are brought before the Board upon submitting a new application. After a brief discussion Ms. Vickers made a motion, seconded by Ms. Yarbrough to approve Mr. Woods application contingent upon him submitting an updated page 6 of the application marking correctly that his application had been previously denied. A roll call was conducted by Ms. Hodge, and the motion carried.

Tennessee Professional Assistance Program (TnPAP) Statistical Report regarding the Peer Assistance Program (8:41:20)

Ms. Teresa Phillips, Executive Director of TnPAP, brought this report. From July 1, 2021–September 30, 2021, TnPAP was monitoring a total of no massage therapist, and no massage establishment owners. During this time, TnPAP received a total of 1 referral for massage therapists, and 1 for massage establishment owners. Both referrals were received through the Board administrative office. Of those referred, both were for arrest history. During this time, TnPAP entered into no agreements with either massage therapists or massage establishment license owners. During this time, TnPAP discharged a total of 1 massage therapist, and no massage establishment owners. The discharge was due to being evaluated with no monitoring recommended.

The Board and the public had no questions or comments for Ms. Phillips.

Public Comments (8:44:00)

Ms. Maj-Lis Nash, Mind Body Institute, asked to Board to provide clarification for TN Law providers regarding grace periods for change of responsible person and late renewal based upon the Board's decision on the Omni Hotel application earlier in the day. Ms. Nash was concerned that the Board granted the license to Ms. Talley with the Omni Hotel without penalties or conditions, even though the establishment operated without a responsible person for 8 months. The establishment also continued to operate and offer services after the renewal had expired and while Ms. Talley's change of responsible person's application was pending due to her requirement to obtain and evaluation from TnPAP. Mr. Velker and Mr. Mullins stated that law providers needed to continue to teach the law as written, and that the Board had flexibility to make decisions on when to apply fines and discipline to licenses without setting a precedent. Ms. Nash thanked the

Board for allowing her to speak her peace, and requested the Board consider her comments at a future meeting.

No additional business was brought before the Board, and the meeting was adjourned at 5:52 pm.

Amanda Fox, LMT- (Time- 0:15:30)

Ms. Fox was not present at the meeting. A motion was made by Mr. Guilford to proceed in default, and he presented a proof of service which was accepted by Judge Waterhouse. A motion was made by Mr. Bolden-Greer and was seconded by Mr. Mullins default. A roll call vote was held and the motion carried. The notice of hearing was read by the Board Members. Ms. Fox has a CE violation for 2013-2014 of 25 hours including 2 hours Law and 2 hours Ethics. Her Massage Therapist license expired March 2017 and was Reinstated in June 2017 following which an audit was performed for the 2013-2014 cycle. Evidence was presented by Mr. Guilford of audit documents including an initial letter requesting proof of completed hours and an Agreed Citation for non-compliance. Testimony from Kim Hodge stated that the current status of Ms. Fox's license is licensed until January 31, 2022. The license previously expired March 2017 due

to the license not being renewed. The proposed offer was made of suspension of License with 31 continuing education hours for the 2013-2014 CE cycle. Assessed civil penalties in the amount of \$1,550, plus costs not to exceed \$1,000 for failure to properly maintain sufficient continuing education credits for the 2013-2014 CE cycle. Once hours have been completed, the license may be placed on probation until all fines are paid. A motion was made by Dr. Bolden-Greer to accept the findings of fact as presented and seconded by Ms. Yarbrough. The motion passed with a roll call vote. A motion was then made to accept the conclusions of law by Dr. Bolden-Greer and seconded by Ms. Vickers. A roll call vote was held and the motion passed. Dr. Bolden-Greer motioned to accept the policy as written and seconded by Ms. Yarbrough. The motion passed with a roll call vote.

The meeting took a brief recess and reconvened with a roll call and a quorum was once again established.

Receive, discuss, and/or update Board on New Business in Administrative Office:

Update on School Meeting held Thursday, October 28, 2021 (Time- 1:22:40)

Ms. Hodge presented a review of the school meeting which was attended by 14 of the 22 approved schools in the state. Video of the meeting will be made available to the public.

Update on Rulemaking Hearing (Time- 1:24:20)

Mr. Guilford presented that the rulemaking to increase fees is moving forward internally in TDH. At this time, it is expected the rule making hearing will occur at the May 2022 Board Meeting. The reciprocity licensure rule revisions are in the drafting stages.

Update on MLTD (Time-1:54:25)

Marc Guilford presented that this matter is still in his office in process. States updates may be made available at the February 2022 meeting.

School Annual Reports (Time- 1:55:45)

Ms. Hodge announces that school reports are due in to the Board Administrative office by December 31, 2021. A report will be made available by Dr. Bolden-Greer at the February 2022 meeting.

Conflict of Interest (Time- 1:58:10)

Annual Conflict of Interest forms were signed by all Board Members.

Receive reports and/or requests from the Board Director/Manager (Time-1:59:05)

Administrator/Director's Report:

This is an Administrative Report from Kimberly Hodge, Board Director. The information contained in this report will keep the Board aware of all essential activity pertaining to licensure for Massage Therapists and Massage Establishments.

Investigation/Disciplinary Report (Time- 2:03:30)

This report was presented by Ms. Jaime Byerly of the Disciplinary Coordinator's Office brought this report. Ms. Byerly informed the Board that Discipline is now under the Office of General Counsel and a report will be available at the February Meeting. Ms. Byerly stated that for this calendar year, the Office of Investigations received 56 new complaints for massage therapists. Of those complaints, 10 were for sexual misconduct, 3 for criminal charges, 4 for unlicensed practice, 19 for unprofessional conduct, 1 for violation of a board order, 1 for criminal conviction, 1 for lapsed license, 1 for practice outside of scope of practice, and 16 for continuing education violations.

During this time, Investigations closed a total of 28 complaints for massage therapists. Of those complaints, 5 were closed due to insufficient evidence to formally discipline, 12 sent to OGC for formal discipline, 1 closed with no violation, 3 with a letter of concern, 7 with a letter of warning. As of October 26, 2021, Investigations had a total of 78 open complaints for massage therapists.

Ms. Byerly stated that this year, Investigations received 31 new complaints for massage establishments. Of those new complaints, 5 were for sexual misconduct, 1 for advertising, 1 for criminal charges, 1 for unlicensed practice, 14 for unprofessional conduct, 2 for lapsed license and 1 for Covid-19.

During this time, Investigations closed 20 complaints for massage establishments. Of those closed complaints, 5 were sexual misconduct, 4 was closed due to insufficient evidence, 5 were sent to OGC for formal discipline, 7 closed with no action, and 4 with a letter of warning. Ms. Byerly reminded the Board that letters of concern and warning are not considered formal discipline. As of October 2021, Investigations had a total of 38 open complaints for massage establishments.

In response to the number of complaints, Mr. Velker pointed out that there are a total of 4505 licensed Massage Therapist in Tennessee with 78 complaints and 1606 licensed Massage Establishments with 35 complaints.

Ms. Byerly presented the Summary of Currently Monitored Providers which will be prepared by the Office of General Counsel going forward. The total of licensees currently monitored for discipline include those on probation, have had their licenses reprimanded, revoked, or surrendered due to a disciplinary Board Order. 137 Massage Therapist and 5 Massage Establishments are currently being monitored.

Financial Report (Time- 02:11:30)

Fiscal Director Alicia Grice presented the July 1, 2020- July 30, 2021 report findings. The Massage Board closed the year in the positive. Allocated expenditures were \$561,00, and a total of \$683,00 of revenue was collected. Carryover total is \$777,000. Ms. Grice will prepare a report to present at the February 2022 Meeting for further discussion to be able to reinstate Massage Establishment inspections.

As of November 5, 2021, there were 4,505 licensed massage therapists and 1,606 licensed massage establishments.

Litigation:

The Office of General Counsel currently has about 90 open cases to the Massage Licensure Board. Approximately 16 of those cases are near resolution and will be closed within the next 30 days. Approximately 15 newly drafted proposed Consent Orders have been mailed in the past 10 days with responses due mid-February.

All open cases in OGC are currently undergoing an intensive file review which will likely result in an increased number of consent orders, agreed orders, and/or notice of charges being presented to the Board in upcoming meetings. This review formally began on 1/23/22 and is in its early stages. A minimum of 10 files are being reviewed a week.

Tabitha Aranda, LMT 7318

Tabitha Aranda was granted Massage Therapist license 7318 in October 2018, which is currently active with an expiration date of April 30, 2023. Her license has never been previously disciplined. Ms. Aranda was employed and practiced at Gould's Day Spa and Salon Houston Levee at 3670 Houston Levee Rd, Suite 107, Collierville TN from about January 2017 through about June 2019. Gould's Salon and Spa Houston Levee was granted Massage Establishment license number 1990 in May 2006, and currently has an expiration date of October 31, 2022. The license was expired from about June 1, 2014 through about December 28, 2018. Ms. Aranda is not the Owner or Responsible Person of Gould's Day Spa Houston Levee and that she was unaware of the license's expired status. Ms. Aranda has violated agreed to pay two (2) Type C penalties for a total of \$200 plus costs not to exceed \$1,000.00 for practicing in an unlicensed Establishment. Her Massage Therapist license is reprimanded effective date of consent entry. A motion was made by Dr. Bolden-Greer to adopt the order and seconded by Ms. Yarbrough, A roll call vote passed the motion.

Anita Lee, LMT 9897

Anita Lee is licensed as a Massage Therapist since January 2013 and her current license expires January 31, 2022. Ms. Lee worked at Adante Day Spa located at 800 Kirkwood Ave, Nashville, which was licensed (ME 1279) from May 11, 2004 and currently has an expiration date of October 31, 2020. Adante Day Spa license is currently in an expired status. The license was expired from about June 1, 2016 through November 1, 2018, during which time it continued to operate. The Establishment license was in active status when Ms. Lee began practicing there. Ms. Lee practiced at Adante Day Spa from on or about January 2015 until February 2019. Ms. Lee is not the Owner

or Responsible Person of Adante Day Spa and states she has no idea that the license had expired. Ms. Lee's Massage Therapist license has never been disciplined. Ms. Lee has agreed to pay civil penalties of \$300.00 plus costs not to exceed \$1,000.00 for practicing in a n unlicensed Establishment. A motion was made by Dr. Bolden- Greer to adopt the order as written and seconded by Mr. Mullins. A roll call vote was held and the motion carried.

Huidong Tain, LMT 11589

Ms. Huidong Tian was licensed as a Massage Therapist in May 2016 and has a current expiration date of December 31, 2022. Ms. Tian for owned and operated massage Establishment, Spa Yang Sheng Tang Inc, at 2400 Madison Street, Suite 9, Clarksville, TN without an Establishment license from about January 2019 through April 2019. Ms. Tian operated the Establishment with another individual Chuhua Wang Dickey. Ms. Tian and Ms. Dickey subsequently applied for an Establishment license from the massage Board and stated at the May 2019 Massage Board meeting that they saw clients and that Ms. Tian was the only licensed therapist working there. They also stated that Ms. Dickey had performed "bodywork hypnosis" on clients which involved pressing trigger points on the client's legs, backs, and arms. Ms. Dickey is not licensed as a massage therapist in Tennessee. Ms. Tian was denied the license for Spa Yang Sheng Teng at the May 2019 Board Meeting based on those facts. Ms. Tian again applied for a Massage Establishment license at this location in 2021, and was again denied based on unlicensed practice and operation in 2019.ms. Tian has agreed to the proposed order of: Massage Therapist license # 11589 placed on probation for two years during which time she may not own, operate, or be the responsible person for a Massage Establishment. Pay civil penalty of total of \$1,300.00 plus costs not to exceed \$3,00.00. Motion was made by Dr. Bolden-Greer to adopt the order as written and was seconded by Ms. Yarbrough. A roll call vote passed the motion.

Christina Mobley, LMT 9327

Christina Mobley has been licensed as a Massage Therapist since on or about January 2012, and currently holds an expiration date of November 20,2021. Ms. Mobley failed to renew her license in 2017 and it expired. Ms. Mobley reinstated her license in 2018 and paid civil penalty for practicing on an expired license. She was also subsequently audited for compliance of the 2015-2016 CE cycle. Ms. Mobley was unable to produce documentation of completing 11 of the required 24 continuing education hours. Ms. Mobley has agreed to the following order: Her license id placed on probation beginning the effective date of this order. Withing two years from the effective date, Ms. Mobley must complete a total of 17 continuing education hours towards the 2015 / 2016 cycle. Ms. Mobley shall pay civil penalty in a total of \$550.00 plus costs not to exceed \$2,000.00. The license will remain on probation until all terms are fully complied. Motion was made by Dr. Bolden-Greer and seconded to by Mr. Mullins to adopt the order as written. The motion carried after a roll call vote.
