Dr. Fair, Ph.D., MLS (ASCP) ^{CM} requested interpretation of *Rule 1200-06-02-.02 (2) (c) (1) Instructor (Classroom and Clinical) Credentials*:

All instructors of medical laboratory subjects shall be licensed laboratory personnel or have met the education requirements of not less than those in these Rules for a medical laboratory technologist.

Dr. Fair presented documentation from the institutional accrediting body, Accrediting Bureau of Health Education Schools (ABHES), that required the faculty of the Fortis program to hold an associate degree and be nationally certified.

Documentation from the National Accrediting Agency for Clinical Laboratory (NAACLS) was also presented. **Standard VII (C) (1)(a): Qualifications** Faculty/instructors designated by the program must:

- i. demonstrate adequate knowledge and proficiency in their areas;
- ii. demonstrate the ability to teach effectively at the appropriate level.

The board concluded that the *Rule 1200-06-02-.02 (2) (c)* (1) may be interpreted to mean that a Medical Laboratory Technician (MLT) can instruct students in a MLT training program, since they are licensed personnel with an associate degree. An instructor does not have to be a Medical Technologist with a bachelor's degree, consisting of 32 hours of biology and chemistry.

A motion was not necessary since this was a board interpretation.
