Dr. Schuler called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m. A roll call vote was conducted and all Board members were present.

### **Minutes**

Upon review of the November 2, 2018 minutes, Mr. Fillauer moved to accept the minutes, seconded by Dr. Sables. All in favor. The motion carried.

### **Investigative Report**

Ms. Lori Leonard reported that for 2018 they have received one (1) new complaint for Podiatric X-ray Operators and one (1) new complaint for Orthotists.

### **Office of General Counsel**

The Rule regarding record-keeping for podiatrists and the revisions to the Rule regarding the length of time that testing is valid were revised at the rulemaking hearing in November to reflect the concerns of the TPMA. Those revised rules were sent to the Attorney General's office, which requested some non-substantive changes. Those changes were made and ultimately approved by the Attorney General's office. The Rules were then sent to the Secretary of State's office, but the

Governor issued a 90-day stay on all new rules. That stay went into effect on the same date that the Rules were sent to the Secretary of State's office. There is a path to have rules adopted even with the stay, which we will explore given how far along in the process we were with these rules. At the February 2018 meeting, the Board indicated that non-DPM licensees of the Board should have a similar Rule as podiatrist for record-keeping. Two different approaches to address this were drafted and presented to the Board at the May meeting. The first is simply a Rule that would adopt the DPM Rule for Orthotists, Prosthetists, and Pedorthists. The second is a Rule that is an effort to reproduce the DPM Rule without inapplicable language (such as prescribing, etc.). Mr. Fillauer advised that he wanted to review the draft language and suggest revisions, if appropriate, before the Board took any action on that proposed Rule. The stay does not affect the Board's ability to consider language for rules. The Board can go ahead and consider the language it would like to adopt for this rule. At this time there are no appeals or civil suits pending.

The Office of General Counsel currently has four open cases pertaining to four respondents who hold DPM licenses. A 320c notice letter has gone to all. A formal Notice of Charges has been filed on one, but service has not yet been obtained. We are awaiting a report from an external expert on another before filing formal charges. We are fairly engaged in settlement discussions with counsel for on the third. The other has only just come over from investigations since the last meeting.

### **Administrative Report**

Ms. Hayes stated as of February 7, 2019 there are 268 active Podiatrists; 131 active X-ray operators; 149 active Orthotists; 143 active Prosthetists and 42 active Pedorthists. Ms. Hayes reviewed the monthly statistical breakdown of the renewed, retired and failed to renew.
