AMENDED POLICY STATEMENT

TENNESSEE BOARD OF PHYSICAL THERAPY

APPROVED DRY NEEDLING COURSES

On June 29, 2016, rule 1150-01-.22 of the <u>General Rules Governing the Practice of Physical</u> <u>Therapy</u> became effective, requiring all physical therapists who want to practice dry needling in the state of Tennessee to, among other things, have taken dry needling specific coursework that meets pre-requisites listed in subsection 1150-01-.22(b). Under subsection 1150-01-.22(b)(3), each course in dry needling specific instruction must be Board approved. All approved courses shall be reviewed by the Board for re-authorization every two years, beginning at the first Board meeting occurring after June of 2018.
