I. Call to Order

A roll call of Board Members was initiated, by Mary V. Bennett, Unit Manager. With a quorum present, the meeting started at 9:05 am.

II. Review and approve minutes from previous meetings

After a review of the February 12, 2021 minutes, Ms. LeAnn Childress, made a motion to approve the minutes as written, with corrections to the location, Dr. Ronald Barredo, seconded the motion. The motion carried.

III. Receive reports and/or requests from the Office of General Counsel

Lara Gill, Senior Associate General Counsel, reported that there are currently zero (0) appeals, fourteen (14) open cases, eight (8) against Physical Therapist, and six (6) against Physical Therapist Assistants.

Ms. Childress, made a motion to have Ms. Gill pull back the rules to make changes to direct access, appointing Dr. Jane David, as the Board liaison, Ms. Kelly O'Connor, seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Ms. Gill, presented the board members with a Consent Order for Wesley Tate – PT No. 11673. Ms. O'Connor, made a motion to approve the Consent Order as written, Dr. Barredo, seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Ms. Gill, presented the board members with an Agreed Order for James E. Burgess – PT No. 8863. Dr. Barredo, made a motion to approve the Consent Order as written, Ms. O'Connor, seconded the motion. The motion carried.

IV. Receive reports and/or requests from the Office of Investigations

Courtney Lilly, Disciplinary Coordinator, reported there are currently thirteen (13) Physical Therapist being monitored, three (3) reprimand, five (5) probation, three (3) suspension, two (2) revocation.

Ms. Lilly, reported there are currently twenty (20) Physical Therapist Assistants being monitored, two (2) reprimand, eleven (11) probation, four (4) suspension, three (3) revocation.

Ms. Lilly, reported six (6) new complaint for Physical Therapists; one (1): action in another state, one (1): unprofessional conduct, one (1): unlicensed professional, one (1): false reporting, one (1): substance abuse, and one (1): COVID-19. Four (4) Closed Complaints: one (1) insufficient evidence, three (3) sent to OGC for formal discipline. There are currently sixteen (16) open complaints being reviewed.

Ms. Lilly, reported one (1) new complaint for Physical Therapist Assistants; one (1): action in another state. Five (5) Closed Complaints: sent to OGC for formal discipline. There are currently four (4) open complaints being reviewed.

V. Receive reports and/or requests from the Division of Health Licensure and Regulation

No report was provided at this time. A fiscal report will be presented at the November 2021 board meeting.

VI. Applicant Interviews/Reviews

Matthew Biggerstaff, PTA – File No. 7837 - After board members reviewed the charges of AWOL, contributing to the delinquency of a minor, and statutory rape, Ms. O'Connor made a

motion to approve Matthew Biggerstaff, examination/application, contingent upon Mr. Biggerstaff undergoing a TnPAP evaluation, that deems Mr. Biggerstaff eligible to practice unencumbered. Additionally, this monitoring evaluation will be sent to the board administrative staff, Dr. Barredo, seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Christian Garcia Castellano PTA – File No 7817 - After board members reviewed the educational credentials of Ms. Castellano, Dr. David, made a motion to deny the application based on The General Rules Governing the Practice of Physical Therapy, that specify the applicant must be a graduate of a physical therapy assistant program accredited by CAPTE and approved by the Board of Physical Therapy, Dr. Barredo, seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Christina Straughen, PTA – File No. 7320 - After board members reviewed the charges of Underage Consumption and DUI, Dr. Barredo made a motion to approve Christina Straughen application, contingent upon Ms. Straughen undergoing a TnPAP evaluation that deems Ms. Straughen eligible to practice unencumbered. Additionally, this monitoring evaluation will be sent to the board administrative staff, Dr. David, seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Padmapriya Indukuri PT – File No 13490 - After board members reviewed the educational credentials of Ms. Indukuri, Ms. O'Connor, made a motion to approve her application, Ms. Childress, seconded the motion. The motion carried.

It was further discussed that a policy statement would be approved for board administrative staff to make a decision to review and approve any internationally trained applicant who has received a CAPTE approved degree in physical therapy (assistant). A motion was made by Dr. Barredo, seconded, by Ms. O'Connor, to approve the policy statement. The motion carried.

Teresa Phillips, representative from TnPAP, reported from July 1,2020 thru March 31, 2021 that one (1) Physical Therapist Assistants were being monitored, and one (1) Physical Therapist was discharged.

Ms. Gill, discussed the following legislation with board members:

A proposed policy statement will be presented to the Board for consideration clarifying Tenn. Code Ann. 63-13-303(4)(B) to clarify when physical therapy services must be discontinued.

Senate Bill 0584 was signed by the Governor on April 21, 2021, and became Public Chapter 130 This bill amends Tennessee Code Ann. § 63-13-303 as it relates to the direct access exception for physical therapists:

SECTION 1. Tennessee Code Annotated, Section 63-13-303, is amended by deleting the current language in subsection (b) and substituting instead the following: (b) A person shall not practice physical therapy, other than upon the referral of a patient by a referring practitioner who is a licensed doctor of medicine, chiropractic, dentistry, podiatry, or osteopathy, unless the person: (1) Holds a doctorate degree from a professional physical therapy program that is accredited by a national accreditation agency recognized by the United States department of education and by the board; or (2) Has completed: (A) At least three (3) years of experience as a licensed physical therapist; and (B) A professional physical therapy program of at least fifteen (15) credit hours that is: (i) Approved by the board; (ii) Offered by an institution of higher education that is accredited by a national accreditation agency recognized by the United States department of education; and (iii) Designed to enable a physical therapist to recognize conditions that require timely referral to an appropriate healthcare - 2 - 002121 practitioner who qualifies as a referring practitioner under subsection (a). SECTION 2. This act takes effect upon becoming a law, the public welfare requiring it (effective date is 4/13/21)

This law change removes the one-year experience requirement for doctorate level physical therapists for purposes of the direct access practice exception. It also allows physical therapists without a doctorate to meet certain educational requirements for the purpose of the direct access practice exception. OGC anticipates that there will need to be a rule change to have current rules align with the direct access language.

SB01072/HB1275 was signed into law on April 13, 2021. It changes to the practice of occupational therapy, including diagnosis ability and dry needling of the upper limb. This bill specifically authorizes telehealth practice for occupational therapists and physical therapists.

Sections 3 and 4 of this bill specifically authorize occupational therapists and physical therapists to practice telehealth. Occupational therapists and physical therapists are permitted to practice telehealth under Tenn. Code Ann. § 63-1-155. According to occupational therapy and physical therapy practitioners, the specific authorization of telehealth practice is needed in their practice act for insurance purposes. This law takes effect on July 1, 2021.

Ms. O'Connor, made a motion to approve the Referral Exceptions and Direct Access Policy Statement as written, Dr. Barredo, seconded the motion. The motion carried.

After another review of Ms. Gill's report on Direct Access, Dr. Barredo, made a motion to have Ms. Gill pull back the rules to make changes to the direct access policy, and to clarify educational and internationally trained reciprocity requirements, appointing Dr. David as the Board's liaison, Ms. O'Connor, seconded the motion. The motion carried
