Ashley Childers called the meeting to order at 9:47am. A roll call was conducted, and a quorum was met.

Katherine Trawick read the Conflict-of-Interest Policy and elaborated on the purpose of the policy to ensure all had clarity on how to proceed with recusals going forward.

Election of Officers

Robert Zylstra made a motion to nominate Ashley Childers to remain as Board Chair. The motion was seconded by Tara Watson and the motion passed.

Kenya Anderson made a motion to nominate Ann-Marie Buchanan as Board Secretary. The motion was seconded by Mr. Zylstra and the motion passed.

Applicant Interviews:

- a) Carol Niehaus: Ms. Niehaus applied for licensure by reciprocity. She appeared before the Board due to her reciprocity application lacking proof that she intends to reside or be employed in the state of Tennessee (pursuant to TCA 63-23-111). The Board questioned the applicants practice intentions and felt as though her intent would meet the requirements. Mr. Zylstra made a motion to approve the application. The motion was seconded by Ms. Buchanan and the motion passed.
- b) Jennifer Hunter: Ms. Hunter applied for clinical licensure by reciprocity but is unable to produce ASWB examination scores. Ms. Hunter appeared before the Board and discussed her practice history, intentions and explained that at the time she obtained licensure in New York in 1990 she was only required to pass a state examination. Ms. Watson made a motion to approve the application. The motion was seconded by Ms. Buchanan, and it passed.
- c) Joanne Clifford: Ms. Clifford applied for clinical licensure by reciprocity but is unable to produce ASWB examination scores. Ms. Clifford appeared before the Board and explained that she passed the California state exam in 2012 but the ASWM examination was not a requirement at that time. Ms. Buchanan made a motion to application. The motion was seconded by Mr. Zylstra, and it passed.
- d) Gregory Jackson: Mr. Jackson applied for clinical licensure by reciprocity but was grandfathered into licensure by two other states and has a record of failing the ASWB examination. The applicant appeared before the Board to discuss is file. Mr. Zylstra made a motion to approve the application. The motion was seconded by Ms. Anderson, and it passed.
- e) Barbara Lee: Ms. Lee applied for clinical licensure by reciprocity but was grandfathered into licensure by North Carolina and licensed through reciprocity by Michigan. Ms. Lee appeared before the Board to discuss her file. Ms. Lee has not taken an ASWB examination and has practiced since 1993. Ms. Watson made a motion to approve the application. The motion was seconded by Ms. Anderson, and it passed.
- f) Virgil Williams: Mr. Williams appeared before the Board to discuss his application for licensure as a master's level social worker but has only taken and passed the clinical ASWB examination. The board advised him to withdraw his LMSW application and apply for LCSW by Reciprocity.

Public Discussion:

Ms. Paula Foster, with Nashville Cares, approached the Board to clarify the original intent of TCA 63-23-111, established in 2008, which requires applicants through reciprocity to reside in Tennessee or be employed in Tennessee. Based on current telehealth practice and the need for more social workers to be licensed in the state, the Board desires for statutory change and a subsequent rule change. Ms. Buchanan motioned to create a Task Force to address proposed rule revisions. The motion was seconded by Mr. Zylstra, and it passed.

Approval of Minutes:

Ms. Buchanan made a motion to approve the November 28, 2022, meeting minutes with a revision to remove Mr. Kenneth White's name from the record. The motion was seconded by Ms. Anderson, and it passed.

Department Reports:

- a) Office of Investigations: Mr. Roger Knowlton presented the summary. There were no questions.
- b) Financial Report: Ms. Keeyona Love presented the fiscal report. There were no questions.
- c) Administrative Report: Ms. Wilson formally introduced herself, gave an update on the unit, and presented the administrative report. There were no questions.
- d) Office of General Counsel: Ms. Trawick presented the disciplinary and general counsel reports.

Presentation of Concern:

Chad Duncan, LCSW, spoke on behalf of the TN Association of Mental Health Organizations on the topic of supervision hours and approved supervisor training requirements; additionally the hardship for licensees in rural areas who do not have access to in-person supervisors. He would like to see a rule change with virtual supervision being 100%, instead of 75%. Mr. Zylstra expressed his reservations on changing it to 100%. The Board clarified that the new 12hr Supervisor CEU requirement will be in effect December 2023.

Conduct New Business:

- a) Correspondence:
 - 1. Linda Moss: Mr. Zylstra made a motion to grant an extension until June 30th for her to complete the CEUs.
 - 2. P.F.: Ms. Buchanan made a motion to deny and encouraged her to find live/interactive online courses to complete her CEUs by the end of the year.
 - 3. Scottie Adams: The Board prefers that every request in the future have a request letter or medical documentation from a physician to support the circumstance. Ms. Buchanan made a motion to contingently approve the extension request if it the administrative office receives sufficient documentation to support the request. The motion was seconded by Ms. Anderson, and it passed.
 - 4. Sheila McGinty: The Board encouraged her to apply for licensure for them to review her supervision hours.
 - 5. Theresa Tankston: The Board requested additional documentation of what she has already completed and how it was completed inaccurately in order to examine her virtual CE exception. Ms. Karen Franklin, Executive Director with NASW, made a comment confirming that live CEU courses does count towards in-person CEU hours.
