Eagleville native enlists in Tennessee Army National Guard

EAGLEVILLE, Tenn. – Pfc. Kyle Ament graduated from the Army’s Basic Combat Training and Air Traffic Control Operator course at Fort Rucker, Alabama, on Feb. 22.

During the intense 7-month program, Ament was trained to track aircraft to maintain safe flight operations in both tactical and non-tactical environments. He is now assigned to 1-107th Air Operations Battalion, headquartered in Tullahoma.

“I am grateful for the skills I gained while at training,” said Ament. “I’m excited to begin my military career as an air traffic control operator.”
