Christiana native becomes Army technical engineer

CHRISTIANA, Tenn. – Pfc. Troy Dougan completed the U.S Army's Advanced Individual Training as a technical engineer at Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri, July 23.

Dougan completed 17 weeks of training learning to supervise and execute construction site development with technical investigation, surveys, drafts, and construction specifications.

"I joined the Guard to be in the military and go through military schooling and training," said Dougan.

Dougan will be assigned to the 278th Armored Cavalry Regiment's Engineer Squadron headquarters in Lebanon.

"The Army training that I have received will further help me in my electrical engineer education that I am about to embark upon," said Dougan.

Dougan graduated from Blackman High School in 2021 and plans to use the Tennessee STRONG Act to further his education this spring by attending Middle Tennessee State University to study commercial construction management.
