Jackson resident is honor graduate from U.S. Army Culinary School

JACKSON, Tenn. – Spc. Charity Lewis, a Jackson resident, graduated from the U.S. Army's Culinary Specialist course in Springfield, Illinois, on June 7, where she was also declared the school's honor graduate.

During the month-long training, Lewis, along with 30 other Soldiers, learned how to prepare nutritious food for thousands of Soldiers and proper sanitation methods. Following graduation, Lewis is now responsible for ordering and inspecting food supplies as well as cook meals for the Soldiers in Humboldt's 30th Combat Sustainment Support Battalion.

"Lewis is a highly motivated Soldier," said Sgt. 1st Class Joshua Bohannon, the 30th's First Sergeant. "She always excels in everything she does.
