Roll Call & Minutes:

Mr. Ryan McGehee opened the meeting and took roll call which confirmed Vice Chairman Wayne Hastings, Mr. Eddie Hood, and Mr. Bobby Pitts as present. Alleged Violator: First Violations Root Cause: Failure to notify Tennessee 811 Finding: In violation for failure to give notice prior to excavation. Specific individuals to take training shall be determined by the Staff.

Update of Training Program by Tennessee 811 and Legislative Update

Mr. Turner reported that in 2020, 109 individuals from 94 organizations were trained; while the program totals are now 456 individuals from 359 organizations have been trained. In 2021, there have been 2 individuals trained with more on the January schedule. The bill from the last legislative session has filed in the State House of Representatives.

Discussion of future topics for next executive committee meeting.

Future discussion topics include clarification of the enforcement board training sessions and the potential number of complaints for the upcoming February meeting were discussed.
