Update of Training Program by Tennessee 811 and Legislative Update

Mr. Turner reported that for 2021 year to date, 52 individuals were trained and there are 4 individuals scheduled for training. Since May of 2020, 123 individuals have completed the online training provided in lieu of in-person training due to COVID-19 concerns. Since the beginning of the program, 506 individuals from 408 organizations have completed training. Mr. Turner reported that there were four cancellations since the last Executive Committee Meeting and only one was charged a cancellation fee of \$85.

Mr. Turner provided an update on the new damage notice process mandated by the new legislation. 811 has been working on updating the ticket format to meet the requirements and it will be available on July 1st.

Discussion of future topics for next executive committee meeting.

Elections for the Executive Committee were discussed under the provisions of the new law, including extension of terms from one year to three years. Elections will be held on August 11, 2021. The ongoing use of online training was discussed and it was noted that the topic will be discussed and likely the subject of a vote at the next Board meeting on August 11th. The Staff provided an update. The meeting opened a public comment period; no one sought to make public comment.
