# **Update of Training Program by Tennessee 811**

Mr. Ingram reported that 654 individuals have been trained since the inception of the program. Too date in 2022, 85 individuals have been trained. There have been 15 cancellations fees assessed for cancellation within the forty-eight hour window. Of the 755 confirmed violations where training was ordered there has been no contact in 154, contact was made in 45, and training was completed in 550.

# Staff Update

As discussed in previous meetings, the new full-time staff position has been posted and applications are being reviewed. There have been 137 complaints received so far year to date. There is a total of \$187,725 in civil fines assessed.
