Tennessee 811 and Staff Updates

The Tennessee 811 training program update was sent out via email and Ms. Kathy Quartermaine was available for questions.

The number of complaints received in January was 53 and 28 in February. There are 54 open investigations. The year to date total is 81. There were 15 administrative closures. The assessed civil penalty total is \$338,225 and the fund balance is \$184,435. The administrative and investigative position will be reposted. The PHMSA grants will be announced in the next several weeks. Mr. Warren will have a booth at the 811 Summit on March 30, 2023. Mr. Conklin will speak at the 811 Summit.

The Staff provided an update on legislative developments, including proposed language with respect to hand-digging and a rumored proposal by the Tennessee Gas Association to expand the size of the Board's executive committee.

Discussion of Future Topics for the Next Executive Committee Meeting

An advertisement designed by 811 for the Board's grant program will be sent to Board members to circulate among stakeholder groups to attract applications to the Board's grant program. March 20th is the deadline for grant applications for the board to consider. Potential legislative language and other information from the legislative update is be sent to the board members.
