² This election item stems from passage of HB 798/SB 782 which adds two (2) seats to the Executive Committee. The legislation has passed both chambers of the General Assembly and was transmitted to Governor Lee on April 13, 2023. Item will be removed from agenda if legislation does not become law by April 25, 2023.

³ Members of the public seeking to make public comments on a specific issue being discussed by the Board may seek recognition by the Chairman to offer relevant comments on the matter at hand or may wait for the formal Public Comment period of the meeting. Members of the Public should not seek recognition from the Chairman during votes.
