## Instructions: Application for Coin-Operated Amusement Machine License and Decals

## General Information

Any person engaged in the business of providing coin-operated amusement machines for public use is required to file an application with the Department of Revenue on or before June 1st of each year for a license to engage in such business. Any person commencing business subsequent to July 1st shall apply for such license prior to the commencement of business. This license will expire on June 30th of each year.

For coin-operated amusement machine license and/or decal renewals or amendments, please use form VID 215 Renewal for Coin-Operated Amusement Machine License and Decals.

Taxpayers should submit online their fully completed license applications and requests for decals, along with the amount from Line 9, by visiting the Department's website at https://tntap.tn.gov/eservices. Alternatively, they may mail the license application and decal fees to the following address. Checks should be made out to the Tennessee Department of Revenue.

Line 9: Add Line 6 and Line 8 for the total amount due. This is the total amount due for both the license and decal fees that should be remitted to the Department of Revenue.
