## Instructions for the Application for Broadband Infrastructure Sales and Use Tax Exemption

#### **General Information**

Tenn. Code Ann. § 67-6-350 provides sales and use tax exemption for equipment, machinery, software, ancillary components, appurtenances, accessories, or other infrastructure that is used in whole or in part in producing broadband communications services, including broadcasting, distributing, sending, receiving, storing, transmitting, retransmitting, amplifying, switching, providing connectivity for, or routing communications services or to provide internet access, including the monitoring, testing, maintaining, enabling, or facilitating of such equipment, machinery, software, or other infrastructure. See Public Chapter 1102 (2022) for complete details.

Broadband communications services means telecommunications services, mobile telecommunication services, video programming services, and direct-to-home satellite television programming services. Internet access means a service that enables users to connect to the internet to access content, information, or other services offered over the internet. Internet access includes 1) the purchase, use, or sale of telecommunications by a provider of internet access to the extent the telecommunications are purchased, used, or sold to provide the internet access service or to otherwise enable users to access content, information, or other services offered over the internet; 2) services that are incidental to the provision of internet access when furnished to users as part of the internet access service, such as a home page, email and instant messaging, to include voice- and video-capable email and instant messaging, video clips, and personal electronic storage capacity; 3) and a homepage, email and instant messaging, to include voice- and video-capable email and instant messaging, video clips, and personal electronic storage capacity, that are provided independently or packaged with internet access. Internet access does not include voice, audio, or video programming, or other products and services that utilize internet protocol or any successor protocol and for which there is a charge, regardless of whether the charge is separately stated or aggregated with the charge for services for internet access.

Estimated total amount of exempt broadband infrastructure purchases is for informational purposes only.

### **Exclusions**

The law specifically excludes personal consumer electronics, including, but not limited to, smartphones, computers, and tablets, and consumer-grade modems and Wi-Fi routers.

#### **Purpose of the Form**

This application serves as a means to apply to the Department of Revenue for authority to purchase or lease equipment exempt under Tenn. Code Ann. § 67-6-350.
