This change order provides for the addition of fire alarm devices on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor, fire ratings on existing shaft penetrations along with required fire dampers, flex conduit instead of rigid conduit, and replacement of 12 chilled water pressure gauges that were inadequate,. The work also includes the replacement of existing door magnetic hold opens, door and mop sinks that were found to be non-functioning. This work also includes user requests to change casework, and deletion of planned ceilings in utility spaces; resulting in a credit; moving casework, adding a wash sink, and the removal of existing electrical floor boxes that are not needed. Additional cost efficiencies include credit for the remaining abatement allowance as this work will be done through an existing environmental contract, as well as a credit to keep existing sinks and replace only the faucets.
