HCA is donating this property to TCAT-Dickson who is partnering with Nashville State Community College (NSCC) to develop a higher education center in Dickson. The new facility will be constructed with funding that was appropriated for the construction of a new facility in the FY 23/24 Capital Budget (Statewide TCAT New Campus Locations \$147,500,000.00) 166/046-03-2023. Under the terms of the donation agreement, HCA will retain the right to purchase the property for fair market value if construction of the facility is not completed or–the property is not operated for educational purposes including the training of nurses. HCA will also retain a right of first refusal if the State receives an offer it wants to accept to sell the property or enter into a disposal lease in the facility to a third party.

The new facility will fill a need for additional higher education opportunities in the area which was identified in the 2023 TCAT Master Plan. The new facility will house TCAT Dickson's healthcare programs, making space at the main campus available for additional program offerings. The new facility will also allow NSCC to relocate from leased space in Dickson and expand healthcare programs. This property is in TCAT-Dickson's 2023 Master Plan Amendment.
