Minutes: 12/20/2021 SBC Lieutenant Governor asked which agency would be the lead agency.

Commissioner Branscom replied that it is a combination of the TN Highway Patrol (THP), Department of Safety and Homeland Security; TN Law Enforcement Training Academy (TLETA); Department of Correction (TDOC); TN Bureau of Investigation (TBI). Lieutenant Governor asked if one of those would be the lead agency. Commissioner Branscom replied that there's not a lead agency but that

this will become the headquarters building for THP and TDOC.

Speaker Sexton asked what the intended purpose would be for the Tullahoma site if this project is approved. Commissioner Branscom

assured the Commission that the State would continue to take care of the property making sure that it is maintained and properly looked after. The intent is to look for an economic development opportunity for that area, something benefical to the city of Tullahoma and the counties there.

Commissioner Eley asked if Commissioner Roth, Department of Economic & Community Development (ECD) had anything he would like to add. Commissioner Roth stated that they are experiencing a shortage of quality shovel ready sites and they are ecstatic if they could bring that asset into their database. He stated that ECD will do everything they can to make sure that site is marketed. Speaker Sexton asked for confirmation that the intended purpose would be economic community development and then to give it back to the city through the Industrial Development Board (IDB) or what would the process look like as the site is being built. Commissioner Roth deferred back to DGS but stated that ECD would not take title. ECD would participate with the site development program, those are project dollars that they use to help the local communities with the development of their sites whether it is expanding water sewer or bringing an access road or simply grading those sites. ECD would work hand in hand with DGS. Speaker Sexton asked if Commissioner Branscom could answer as well. Commissioner Branscom replied that it is the Governor's intent to get it transferred to an IDB in order to get the property into a productive use. Speaker Sexton asked if the property could be used as a park, if that's what the community needed, or if it could just be used as for an industrial development. Commissioner Branscom replied that it could become a park, depending on how the community wants it to be used. DGS was thinking on an economic development opportunity that would create jobs which is why she had spoken with Commissioner Roth. Speaker Sexton asked if there has ever been any conversation with the locals about what the State is willing to work with them on. Commissioner Branscom stated that she has not had any of those conversations.

The Commission approved selecting 6 additional designers and utilizing CM/GC alternative delivery method for the remainder of the work.
