Comment:	Three bids were received on Wednesday, October 7, 2020. Tradesman Group, Inc. submitted the lowest bid and has been deemed the Best Value proposer. The work of this project includes the repair and stabilization of the retaining wall along Eakin Weakly Drive (west side of the Capitol) as well as the repair and reconfiguration of the Jackson Garden limestone pavers; bronze handrails on the north, south, east, and west, steps to the Capitol; iron gates at the southeast and southwest corners along Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd; new Cordell Hull and 6 th Avenue upper steps on the east side of the Capitol; new grand steps on the north side of the Capitol; new bench at Polk Tomb; new cobblestone pavers at 6 th Avenue crossing; ADA access path from the Capitol to the Jackson Garden; and general maintenance to existing handrails, landscaping and irrigation on the site. Additional funding is being requested to award a construction contract for the base bid and one alternate (the ADA ramp). The increase in project budget is due to construction cost increases in the Nashville area over the past eight years.
