#### **Other Business**

State Architect Ann McGauran introduced Keith King with the Tennessee Board of Regents.

Mr. King stated that TBR would like to request approval of a change in Designer for Volunteer State Community College, Warf Science Building Addition and Renovation, SBC 166/025-01-2017 and Volunteer State Community College, Ramer Renovations, SBC 166/025-02-2017 projects from the Joint Venture Firm of J Holmes Architecture/ Lyle Cook Martin Architects to Lyle Cook Martin Architects.

This request is made as a result of the selection of Tennessee National Guard Major General Jeff Holmes, the principal of J Holmes Architecture, as the Commissioner and Adjutant General of the Tennessee Department of the Military and will allow these projects, which are in construction or construction bidding, to continue to move forward. Treasurer Lillard stated that he wanted to make sure that TBR was documenting the termination of those contracts in an appropriate manner that was signed off on by all the parties and confirmed that MG Holmes would retain liability for any work he did prior to the date of severance for which he was paid, the way any professional would.

The Commission approved Lyle Cook Martin Architects be selected as the designer for the two projects.

Secretary Hargett thanked Commissioner Martin for his service. Commissioner Martin thanked the Commission and stated that it has been an honor, pleasure and a privilege to serve in the various capacities. Commissioner Martin stated that he appreciates all the work and effort the other members put forth for the State and he has learned a lot and is grateful for the experience of having the opportunity to serve with the other members. Lieutenant Governor thanked Commissioner Martin, shared his pleasure in working with the Commissioner, and his appreciation for the work Commissioner Martin has done with the SBC and as Commissioner of Finance & Administration. It is a difficult job which requires saying "no" a lot and the Lieutenant Governor shared that Commissioner Martin did so with the ability to make people feel grateful in his decision.
