Lieutenant Governor McNally stated that the purpose of this meeting was to consider the items on the agenda for the January meeting of the State Building Commission. If the actual cost to replace and repair these buildings is greater than estimated, an increase in funding would come to the SBC for approval. Assessment and analysis continue for the Hoop Houses, Broiler House, Goat/Cattle Facility, Weight Shed, and

the Farm Operations Shed.

Hoar Construction, LLC is requested for preconstruction and CM services for building reconstruction. Hoar Construction was selected and is currently under contract for the TSU campus project 166/01-02-2016, TSU Health Sciences Facility. The campus has been using Hoar Construction for pre-construction services for this emergency project at no cost since they have mobilized and have a working protocol with TSU. Hoar Construction has significant experience with renovation and reconstruction projects of this type and is willing to extend the percentage fee it is charging for the TSU Health Sciences Facility to this project. This percentage fee is lower than what has been proposed for other recent projects of this size and scope and is believed to be better than would be offered in response to an advertised procurement. TBR/TSU will continue to work with the state insurance and adjusters to determine the final project value. Campus is performing ongoing repairs.
