Lieutenant Governor McNally questioned if the Department knew how much additional money will be requested from the General Assembly for the infrastructure. Commissioner Rolfe replied that ECD has worked with the Department of General Services for this information. The approximate remaining amount needed at maximum capacity would be \$70-\$80 million, but that the requested amount would depend on the needs of the tenant.

Lieutenant Governor McNally asked if a tenant does not need the wastewater pipeline, would the Department still build it for other tenants. Commissioner Rolfe replied that it would be helpful for other tenants and would still like to build the pipeline.

Lieutenant Governor McNally asked about workforce issues associated with recruiting a tenant. Commissioner Rolfe stated that the workforce issue continues to be a greater challenge today than it was in the past, due to low unemployment rates in the State. The Commissioner stated that from looking at the labor shed, the Department believes the necessary workforce is available within a 30-90 minute drive. Commissioner Rolfe stated that ECD uses their TCAT partnership when they are out recruiting companies to show how Tennessee has and can have a qualified and educated workforce.

Speaker Harwell asked if the Department would be shovel ready when the pipeline is finished or if ECD would need to come back for the \$70-\$80 million before having a tenant. Commissioner Rolfe replied that ECD would come back to the Commission for the additional money after they have a tenant.

Comptroller Wilson confirmed that ECD will have, within the control of the site, power, gas, rail and roads and is really just waiting on the wastewater pipeline. Commissioner Rolfe stated that the wastewater required external permitting and easement rights that the other utilities do not. Comptroller Wilson asked if ECD has the permits in place for the disposal into the

Mississippi River. Commissioner Rolfe replied "yes". Comptroller Wilson asked if ECD would be able to complete the infrastructure once they have received the easements, recognizing that ECD won't know the requirements until they have a tenant. Commissioner Rolfe replied "yes".

Comptroller Wilson asked if it would be premature to look at the engineering of the pipeline to make sure it would work. Deputy Commissioner John Hull with the Department of General Services replied that their engineering firm, SSOE, has designed the wastewater treatment line and plant for this project. It has been designed for 3.5 million gallons a day of wastewater assuming all 4,000 acres are built out with tenants on the site.

Comptroller Wilson asked if water is available to meet demands that may come up. Deputy Commissioner Hull replied that it is their understanding that sufficient water is available. Comptroller Wilson stated that he wants to make sure that everything is in place and asked if, before start of further expenditures, there would be a complete review to ensure everything is in order. Deputy Commissioner Hull replied "yes".
