Commissioner Rolfe replied that several years ago a significant portion of the pipe was purchased, approximately three million dollars worth, and is in storage in North Dakota. Lieutenant Governor McNally asked about the condition of the pipe. Commissioner Rolfe replied that they are confident in the quality of the stored pipe and that the pipe has a life expectancy of many decades.

Lieutenant Governor McNally stated that Senator Ed Jackson, Senator Paul Rose, Senator Page Walley (in attendance), and Senator Brian Kelsey are in support of the construction of the pipeline.

The Commission approved a revision in project budget and funding and utilizing Best Value alternative delivery method for a portion of the work.
