State Architect Peter Heimbach stated that Scott Frick, attorney representing Atlas Coatings, Inc., was present to appeal the ruling made by the Bid Error Review Panel.

Mr. Frick was recognized and provided information as to his position on the case. He stated that Atlas considered their mistake to be an omission of "a substantial quantity of work, labor, material or services…" as referenced in the SBC Policy. He explained that, with the State accepting the next lowest bid, it was still able to obtain the work for less than the apparent budget and experienced no monetary harm as a result of his client being allowed to withdraw his bid. Mr. Frick requested that the State Building Commission reject the findings of the Bid Error Review Panel and permit Atlas Coatings, Inc. to withdraw its bid without forfeiture of the bid security.

Treasurer Lillard questioned the fact that the other bidders had properly interpreted the specs, and asked the amount of the bid security. Mr. Heimbach responded that the bid security was approximately \$23,000. He said the discussion by the Panel was that a substantial portion was not omitted but, rather, the wrong materials were used instead. He said that Atlas made a judgment error in not seeking clarification on that issue. In response to questions from Lieutenant Governor Ramsey and Commissioner Martin, Mr. Heimbach explained how the Bid Error Review process worked and the difference between judgmental and clerical errors. The Commission acknowledged that some good arguments were made, but expressed concern over the interpretation of the policy and setting a dangerous precedence. Treasurer Lillard made a motion to defer action until the next SBC meeting after seeking advice from the Attorney General. Motion was seconded and carried.
