The State has the right to replenish the pool, as needed to maintain a minimum number of contractors in the pool, upon approval by the State Architect. Use of the IDIQ delivery method will be approved in accordance with SBC policy on a project by project basis. The lowest bidding contractor from the pool will be awarded a contract for the

work in accordance with procurement law.

Individual project contracts will only require the signature of the Deputy Commissioner of STREAM, the contractor, and the State Architect. The total cost of the projects utilizing IDIQ

contracts will not exceed \$13 million per year without SBC approval.
