Comment:

The University of Tennessee at Knoxville (UTK) operates the VolShop to serve the University community and the general public. The University proposes to lease space for a VolShop on the western side of the campus (see attached map) from UC Retail (UCR), LLC. The space proposed will be co-located in a new Walmart and Publix shopping center under development by University Commons (UC) which is scheduled to open August 2014. UCR and UC are sister LLC's with the same principals.

A retail development of this type, and the proposed lease space, are considered unique and rare due to its location in the footprint of the campus master plan and adjacent to the core of campus. It is situated directly between UTK's main campus, UT Institute of Agriculture campus and Sorority Village. The area of the retail center will attract a large volume of pedestrian traffic from the University community. Its location is in close proximity of student residence halls, class/lab buildings and in a high traffic area where most students, faculty and staff traverse on a daily basis.

In years 1-5, the proposed base rent is \$23.00 per square foot per, or \$138K per year. In years 6-10, the base rent would increase to \$27.00 per square foot, or \$162K per year. As described in the table above, additional rent of \$9.90 per square foot includes other expenses paid to landlord that when added to the base rent increases the total annual cost per square to \$32.90 in years 1-5 and \$36.90 in years 6-10. The proposed term would commence in the summer of 2014 when the Landlord delivers the space. The total cost during the 10-year term of the lease would be approximately \$3.84M. The University may terminate the lease for cause related to conflict of interest, lack of funding by the appropriate Legislative Body, or default by Landlord.

Minutes:

07/10/2014 ESC Robbi Stivers presented the request. Commissioner Martin disclosed that, because of his past experience while with the City of Knoxville and since he was personal friends with the developers, he thought it appropriate to recuse himself from voting. Secretary Hargett stated that, while the project was unusual, it was not inappropriate. The Subcommittee voted in favor to approve the request, with Commissioner Martin abstaining.
