Architects. Mr. Hinton presented the design and location of the monuments. Lieutenant Governor McNally asked if the monuments would include the names of those who were killed in the wars. Mr. Hinton replied that names were not currently in the design. Commissioner Grinder stated that it is very difficult to be 100% correct and in order not to inadvertently offend anyone because a name was left off or inappropriately included Veterans Services had decided not to include the names of those who died in the war on the monuments. Also, the purpose of the monument is to honor all those who served not just those who were killed. In the recent wars, because of how personnel were utilized and how they report their 'home address' it was very difficult to determine with complete accuracy those Tennesseans who had made the ultimate sacrifice. Lieutenant Governor McNally stated that he feels strongly that there should be some recognition for those who paid the ultimate sacrifice. Commissioner Grinder stated that they would be happy to meet and discuss this further.

Treasurer Lillard stated that with today's technology there should be an ability to reference a website that would give more detailed information on the War itself, those who served, and what it means to Tennesseans, since the monuments have limited surface space. He asked if the Department had considered providing such a reference on the monument. Commissioner Grinder stated that they will look into adding a reference to a website. Treasurer Lillard asked what the maps would show and Mr. Hinton stated that the maps would show where the operations occurred.

Other increases that had impacted projects include labor market increases, especially in Middle Tennessee, and increases in steel, aluminum and concrete costs due to the demand. Mr. Tracy relayed that TBR watches all the bids and some come in under the estimate. He also noted that when the cost is higher than the estimate; the designer does not get

an increase in fees.

This change order provides for a number of hidden conditions such as additional support framing for an existing roof soffit and additional framing for gypsum board finishes, electrical feeder line splices required, a steel relief angle required to carry a new brick veneer at the basement wall area, and modifications to interfaces between the HVAC ductwork and plumbing piping infrastructure. Work includes additional steel required to be welded onto existing leg of relief angles due to designer error and additional steel bracing required to support top of some new CMU wall that was not addressed on the designer documents. This change order also addresses owner added scope for electrical runs for wireless access points that were added after the project bid, and a credit back to the project for a deduct to change the finish of some sunshades and a change from wood paneling to gypsum board wall finish for upper level bedrooms.
