Persons employed by local school systems as interpreters for students who are deaf, deaf-blind, or hard of hearing must meet the requirements for licensure outlined in State Board Rule 0520-02-02-.04 or satisfy the employment standards requirements outlined in State Board Rule 0520-01-02-.03(10I)

LEAs will show good faith effort in hiring educational interpreters who hold the School Services Personnel licensure for Educational Interpreters. If a candidate holding this licensure is not available, school systems may employ interpreters consistent with State Board Rule 0520-01-02-.03 (10)
