




TIBRS TRAINER TALK PART ONE

ABBY

With the 2021 Data Review just around the corner, I would like to remind everyone of the Counting Methodology for TIBRS. For Crimes Against Persons, one offense is counted for each victim involved in the incident. For example, a man with a knife stabbed 2 people and threatened 10 more during an argument at a football game. This incident would be reported as Aggravated Assault. However, your crime count will be 12, because the count reflects the number of persons assaulted. For Crimes Against Property and Crimes Against Society: Each offense is considered a distinct operation, so the count will reflect one, regardless of the number of victims. There is one exception in Crimes Against Property. For Motor Vehicle Theft, the number of vehicles is counted. Your crime count for Motor Vehicle Theft will be the number of vehicles stolen in an incident.

COUNTING METHODOLOGY
CRIMES AGAINST PROPERTY/SOCIETY

In Crimes Against Property and Crimes Against
Society, the offender's objective/intent is to
obtain money, property or some other benefit.

FOR COUNTING PURPOSES
In these categories, offenses are considered
distinct operations, so the count will reflect
one, regardless of the number of victims.

SIGNING UP FOR TIBRS TRAINING

<u>TIBRS Overview & Report Writing</u> is a beneficial class for officers and supervisors needing a better understanding of TIBRS. This class is P.O.S.T. certified for 8 hours.

<u>RAC Orientation/CrimeInsight</u> does not count toward initial or recertification training requirements for RACs and/or Alternate RACs.

However, due to the many advantages of using CrimeInsight, such as Mapping and details on how to run and build reports, we highly recommend that RACs and Alternate RACs attend this class!

FROM THE AUDITORS

DEBBIE, RANDALL, AND THOMAS

A victim's vehicle was broken into in a parking lot. Stolen items included a purse (value: \$100) containing credit cards, driver's license (zero value), make-up (value: \$25), and a hunting knife (value: \$50).

What offense do you report to TIBRS? *Theft from a Motor Vehicle*.

What are the property categories? *Purse/Handbags/Wallet; Credit/Debit Cards; Identity Documents* (driver's license); Consumable Goods (make-up); and Weapons-Other (hunting knife).

Let's look at the same scenario again, but this time the only property stolen was the car battery, (value: \$100).

What do you report to TIBRS? *Theft of Vehicle Parts or Accessories*.

Property: *Motor Vehicle Parts/Accessories*.

Even though TCA allows a law enforcement officer to *charge* the offender with Burglary/Breaking and Entering, why not report Burglary/Breaking & Entering to TIBRS? *A vehicle does not meet the TIBRS definition of burglary*. Part of the NIBRS/TIBRS definition of burglary is *Unlawful entry into a building or other structure*.

The charge may be Burglary/Breaking & Entering, but for **TIBRS**, the two examples above would be reported as Theft from a Motor Vehicle and Theft of Motor Vehicle Parts or Accessories, respectively.
