2012 Preliminary Data Review Sent to Agencies

The CSU has completed the preliminary review of the 2012 TIBRS data for the upcoming annual publications. Your agency should have received a preliminary "Crime in Tennessee" report documenting 2012 offenses reported to TIBRS. Colleges and universities should have received preliminary "Crime on Campus" reports. Additionally, agencies reporting any bias motivated and/or LEOKA offenses should have received the respective preliminary reports.

Please thoroughly review these reports for potential errors and/or omissions in your agency's statistics. This is a very important part of the publication process as we

want the final publications/reports to be the most accurate reflection possible of 2012 TIBRS data.



If you have any questions or concerns, feel free to contact anyone in the Crime Statistics Unit for assistance. (See page 6 for complete contact list). Please be mindful of the deadlines for entering any necessary corrections into your software or verifying accuracy of your agency's data. All agencies utilizing

TnCOP software must make their final changes by February 28th. Vendor agencies must check with their respective vendors for a TIBRS deadline. The very last day to submit updated files is March

REMINDER: Check Your Error Files (TnCOP Agencies Only)

The CSU LEICs would like to remind all TnCOP agencies to regularly check the error files in TnCOP. If an incident has an error in TnCOP, that particular incident WILL NOT come

ERROR

through with the monthly data file submission.

As such, it is important to regularly reconcile any errors that exist in TnCOP so that your agency's TIBRS data is accurately reflected each month. If you have difficulties correcting any errors that exist in TnCOP, please feel free to contact any member of CSU and we will gladly assist you.

The Error Report link is located on the left side of the TnCOP main page under the "RMS Search" section. For your convenience, a partial screenshot of the TnCOP main page is provided to the right with the Error Report link circled in red.

TIBRS Incident Report Forms Updated on the TBI Website

Updated incident report forms have been posted on the TIBRS Law Enforcement Only page of the tbi.tn.gov website. Included in these forms are the TIBRS changes effective March 1st, 2013.

For your convenience, the forms are fillable (can be completed electronically and saved) as well as printable. A direct link to TIBRS Law Enforcment Only Page is provided below.

This page is password protected. The username is "lawenforcement" and the password is "Tennesseel". The link to the updated incident report forms, titled "Incident Form 1", is located towards the bottom of the page under the heading "TIBRS Forms".

Changing RACs or Alt. RACs? Things to Know

When there are personnel changes that affect TIBRS within your agency, please notify Steven Jancarek of the CSU as soon as possible. Agencies with newly appointed RACs or Alt. RACs should complete the RAC/Alt. RAC Change Form posted in the Law Enforcement Only section of the tbi.tn.gov website and return it to the CSU via email or fax. Below the image of the RAC/Alt. RAC Change Form is a direct link to the form on the website.




TIBRS RAC/Alt. RAC Change Form

Additionally, new RACs should obtain the required 16 hours of TIBRS training within six months of the RAC change effective date. Any of the CSU staff can assist you with any questions your agency may have about changing RACs and Alternate RACs.

Using TnCrimeOnline Website

The Crime Statistics Unit would like to re-emphasize the usefulness of the Tennessee Crime Online website for the purpose of monitoring TIBRS data submitted by your agency. All TIBRS submitting law enforcement agencies as well as colleges/universities are provided access to Tennessee Crime Online. Utilizing this online tool, agencies can generate their Crime in Tennessee or Crime on Campus page; assess the TIBRS data levels using year-to-date and/or monthly comparisons; and review the agency's monthly error report. In addition to the previously described functions, agencies have the ability to run Quality Control ("QC") reports that help identify potential audit findings. Tennessee Crime Online allows the agencies full access to their TIBRS data at all times. The screenshot to the right shows the actual Crime Online website and some of the reports made available to agencies.

The CSU strongly encourages all agencies to use the site as needed throughout the year. If your agency does not have current access to TN Crime Online, please contact a member of the CSU and we will assist you. We are also available to provide assistance with navigating the site and using its functions.
