Free Application for Remote Audits

Last year, the CJIS Support Center began doing remote audits for agencies with vendor software. This year we are hoping to audit several more agencies using this method in an effort to save time and travel expenses. Because we will be in our office performing an audit in your office, it is required that you open a gateway in order for us to access your data. There are several free applications that will allow you to do this with the internet; however, one of the easiest to use is free software called join.me.

If your agency is scheduled for a TIBRS audit in 2015, please let us know if you would like information about how the remote audit process would work. Please remember, the remote audits are for agencies with vendor software only. It does not apply to TnCop.

Annual Crime Publication Reminders

Please remember the following points as we prepare for the release of annual crime publications:

- Incidents with errors are not included in the reports. Please correct all incidents located in your agency's error reports promptly
- We will include a list of agencies currently decertified for TIBRS compliance at the front of Crime in Tennessee
- Agencies with questionable data identified during the yearly review process may be footnoted if issues were not addressed or explained

Editing and Submitting Old TIBRS Incidents

Recently, several TIBRS agencies have contacted the CJIS Support Center concerning editing and submitting old TIBRS incidents. Please remember that anytime you edit an incident originally submitted prior to the March 1st, 2013 TIBRS changes, the edited incident must comply with the current reporting standards. Once we deploy changes to the system, all data in the submission file regardless if it is new or old has to comply with the "in effect" reporting requirements.

<u>Example:</u> A January 2013 incident involving Simple Assault and a Spouse Victim to Offender relationship that is edited in May 2013 (after implementation of the Domestic Violence flag with March 1st changes), will now require a Yes or No response to the Domestic Violence question in the TIBRS Victim Segment.

Agencies will receive an e-mail via the list serv with instructions for accessing Crime in Tennessee, Hate Crime, and LEOKA on SharePoint. Colleges and Universities will be sent the link and password to review Crime on Campus via an e-mail from Kelsie Conrad.
