Crime in Tennessee Data Deadline

TBI is very appreciative of the hard work agencies demonstrate in keeping their TIBRS data current. The Tennessee program is regarded very highly on a national level and that is due in large part to the work done by the submitting agencies, colleges and universities.

We will begin compilation of the annual Crime in Tennessee report on March 14, 2016. All data files should be submitted to TBI by close of business on March 10, 2016. Any data submitted after March 10th will not be included in the annual report. We thank you for working with us on those deadlines. We will be providing that report on Sharepoint once it is finalized at least one week prior to public release. You may also run your individual Crime in Tennessee page at any time during the year on the law enforcement site for TnCrimeonline.com.

QC Exception Report—Reminder

Many of your agencies have received the QC Exception Report which is a consolidated report containing all QC issues for your agency. When you receive the report, please review the data carefully and make necessary corrections. However, if your review determines that the incident information is reported correctly, please let one of the TIBRS staff know and we can mark the incident correct and it will no longer appear on the QC Exception Report for your agency. We need to know the incident number, your agency ORI and the reason you believe the incident is correct.

Shoplifting vs. Burglary

Per the FBI, we are changing the way the following scenario is reported:

Scenario: A man in Wal-Mart stuffed a DVD under his jacket. He then went past the cash registers to the Refund Desk. He claimed he bought the DVD but lost his receipt, so they gave him a gift card for \$21.87.

In the past, we have recommended reporting the scenario as Shoplifting and Fraud. Effective immediately, we are no longer recommending the Shoplifting offense. There is no need to report the shoplifting, because the initial intent is to defraud Wal-Mart of cash. This does not change what the man is charged with, just the way it is reported to TIBRS.

Some agencies have also contacted us about another issue with charging someone with shoplifting. A large retailer wants to charge repeat offenders with burglary instead of shoplifting based upon the following circumstances: after the first shoplifting offense, offenders are banned from access to all of the chain's stores. If a banned person enters one of the stores, they are considered trespassing. If the same person shoplifts, after being banned from the stores, they meet the definition of burglary. The person should be charged with burglary under TCA guidelines; however the offense should still be reported as Shoplifting to TIBRS.

Reporting Kratom

The drug Kratom (Mitragyna speciosa) is illegal in Tennessee. If it is seized in an incident, it should be reported as an Other Narcotic—drug code "H". This classification is based upon lab testing done by the FBI.

Please Note the Following When signing up for classes

<u>TIBRS Overview & Report Writing</u> classes <u>do not</u> count toward initial or recertification training requirements for Reporting Agency Coordinators (RACs) or Alternate RACs.

TNCrimeOnline (Entry or Advanced level) classes <u>do not</u> count toward initial or recertification training requirements for Reporting Agency Coordinators (RACs) or Alternate RACs. However, due to the many advantages of using TNCrimeOnline, we highly recommend that RACs and Alt. RACs attend the classes if at all possible.
