Incident Report Forms Updated

Updated Incident Report forms are now available on the Tennessee Incident Based Reporting System portion of the TBI website. Though some revisions were made, the new form is very similar to the previous version in formatting and content.

Two types of incident report forms are available for your convenience: a fillable, pdf format that allows information to be entered directly onto the form and saved on the computer; as well as a printable form.

The forms should have all required information on them. Additionally, supplemental reports for offense, offender/arrestee, victim, vehicle/witness/complainant are also provided. A separate Group B Arrest form is provided in both formats.

N-DEx Update

It has been nearly one year since Tennessee began participating in the FBI's Law Enforcement National Data Exchange (N-DEx). N-DEx provides Law Enforcement agencies across the country the ability to access statewide data. Additionally this resource makes other states' records available along with records from various federal agencies such as the FBI, DEA, ATF and Bureau of Prisons. As of November 7, 2011, N-DEx contained a total of 124,161,628 records nationwide. Of those records, the state of Tennessee accounted for 4,903,930 incidents and arrests dating from 1997 to December 2, 2010. We appreciate all the dedication and hard work contributed by every agency to help make Tennessee's N-DEx participation a success. TBI plans to begin submitting the data from December 2, 2010 forward in the next few weeks and then begin sending data to the program on a weekly basis.



Categorization of Synthetic Drugs

There are several drugs/diverted drugs, both old and new, that are not yet listed in our Data Collection manual. How are they classified for NIBRS/TIBRS?

Per the FBI as of November 3, 2011:

Methylenedioxymethamphetamine (MDMA), aka Ecstasy, XTC, E, X, Thizz, Rolls, etc.

Classify as K: Other Hallucinogens

Methylenedioxypyrovalerone (MDPV) and derivatives, aka Bath Salts, Plant Food, Ivory Snow, Ivory Wave, Purple Wave, Vanilla Sky, Red Dove, Bliss, White Lightning, Hurricane Charlie, etc.

Classify as M: Other Stimulants

Synthetic Marijuana, aka JWH-018, RCS-4, RCS-8, AB-001, K2, Spice, Herbal Incense, etc.

Classify as K: Other Hallucinogens

Ketamine, aka Special K, K, etc.

Classify as J: PCP

Methoxetamine, aka NBOMe-2CC, etc. Classify as K: Other Hallucinogens



Arrest Related Deaths

The TBI will soon begin collecting data on all statewide Arrest Related Deaths. CSU will manage the data collection process and submit information directly to the Bureau of Justice Statistics (BJS). The CSU is implementing a web based program for all Tennessee agencies to report deaths in custody. It should be noted that the statistics will not be published, only reported to BJS.

There are specific conditions that constitute an Arrest Related Death. The BJS defines Arrest Related Deaths as those deaths occurring "in the process of arrest". As such, all persons in the physical custody or under physical restraint from law enforcement at the time of death qualify as Arrest Related Deaths. This includes individuals who die attempting to elude police during apprehension as well as those who are confined to a jail. Agencies should report all deaths resulting from intoxication, suicide, accidental injury, illness, and natural causes. Additionally, those deaths caused by law enforcement use of force will also be documented as Arrest Related Death.

More detailed information and instruction will be provided as we move forward. The CSU appreciates your cooperation as we deploy the Arrest Related Deaths system.

New Class for 2012!



This will be an eight-hour review class and will be taught regionally. It will be available as a training option for all RACs and Alternate RACs working at colleges/universities. The class does not count toward initial certification, but does count toward your annual eight-hour training requirement after the initial 16 hour training requirement is met. If you choose, you may still attend a review class under the current format, but this particular class was created with colleges and universities in mind.

TnCOP Software Classes

Beginning in 2012, TnCOP classes will **only** be offered to <u>NEW</u> Reporting Agency Coordinators and <u>NEW</u> Alternate Reporting Agency Coordinators. Seating in our computer classroom is extremely limited. The software is very, very user friendly. Once someone has taken the class and used the software for even a short period of time, there is no need for a "refresher" course.
