FBI COMMUNICATION OF CHANGES TO NIBRS

The FBI has changed the communication process for changes/updates to the NIBRS data collection and edits. They will release updates on a monthly basis through Technical Operational Updates (TOU) for NIBRS. We will post these releases at http://www.tn.gov/tbi/article/tibrs-manuals-information-handouts

Additionally, the FBI's NIBRS Technical Specification 3.0 is also posted at the same location. We understand that it takes time to implement changes. We typically try to allow a six month window for state changes. We will communicate with agencies and vendors the deadlines for when these changes should be implemented in records management systems and allow time to do so. We believe the FBI will be phasing in changes over the next few years as well.

ARREST AND CUSTODY DEATHS REPORTING

All law enforcement administrators were recently mailed a letter from TBI Director Mark Gwyn about the requirement of reporting arrest and custody deaths. This is a federal and state reporting requirement. Failure to collect this data would cause the state to lose a percentage of its federal criminal justice grant awards.

TBI will begin collecting the information utilizing Adobe PDF forms on January 1, 2017. The forms will be posted on the TBI website. Eventually, these data collections will be electronic once the new system is in place. Details about the actual reporting and the TBI point of contact will be provided in December. We ask that all law enforcement agencies proactively send in these reports as events happen but TBI will also be monitoring open source systems for any occurrences as well to ensure all events are reported.

OFFENSE LOCATION

Offense locations should be reported as descriptively as possible to provide detailed information for an incident which can lead to identification of crime patterns or trends. A location type should be reported to show where each incident took place.

TIBRS now accepts two location codes per incident offense.

The first code will be the primary code, which will be submitted to the FBI.

If you report two location codes, they must be different codes.

EXAMPLE: An offense occurs in a restaurant parking lot.
Parking/Drop Lot/Garage should be submitted as the first location code

Cyberspace (58) cannot be reported as the primary location code and cannot be the only location code submitted in an incident. It can only be used as a secondary location. For locations other than Cyberspace (58), the second location code is recommended but not mandatory. If you have only one location to report in an incident, and it is not Cyberspace, leave the secondary location field blank.

UNKNOWN OFFENDER ISSUE:

We are currently having an issue with suspect information, especially for unknown suspects. If you have a known suspect, we expect agencies to enter all of the applicable suspect information. Sometimes you will have an unknown suspect, and agencies are opting out of entering anything for that suspect. Please do not do this. If you have any information on a possible suspect, enter it. We will except unknown data for unknown suspects, but please put in as many descriptors as you can.

LINKING PROPERTY TO OFFENSE ISSUES

We have had several agencies that received submittal errors linking property and offenses. If the property loss type is 1—None or 8—Unknown no property description can be entered. Since the property description fields must be blank, then the offense linkage fields should be blank as well.

TNCrimeOnline classes <u>do not</u> count toward initial or recertification training requirements for Reporting Agency Coordinators (RACs) or Alternate RACs. However, due to the many advantages of using TNCrimeOnline, we highly recommend that RACs and Alt. RACs attend the classes if at all possible. Due to limited seating, **TnCOP Software** classes are for new users only.
