Changing Records Management System (RMS) Vendors

Occasionally, we will receive notifications from agencies that they plan to change records management system vendors—sometimes after the fact. We will work with you as you transition to a new vendor but we also need to ensure that your data submissions remain accurate and complete. We ask that the following process be followed to change RMS vendors.

Your agency must send TBI a letter (preferably a couple of months before you wish to change) on agency letterhead **signed by the Chief or Sheriff**. The letter must contain the following information: the date you plan to change or begin testing; the name of the new vendor; vendor contact information; and if your agency will continue submitting data with your current system as you test with the new vendor. Your agency has the option to waive dual submissions but the new vendor files could impact your TIBRS certification/compliance if the file will not process or the error rate is 4% or higher. Upon receipt of the letter, we will contact your agency with additional instructions. Please note that if your agency 's data is currently submitted to the Tennessee Fusion Center, the new vendor may not have that capability and will need further specifications for that process and we recommend that functionality be included with vendor contracts.

July 2016 TIBRS Changes and TnCrimeonline

TnCrimeonline contains the changes that were effective July 1, 2016. Data is current based upon the previous day's file processing. Many of your RMS vendors were prepared to deploy the changes on July 1 or shortly after that date. These vendors began testing the changes with us as early as March and we are very appreciative of their diligence to ensure the changes were ready at your agencies.

However, a few vendors were not ready to implement the changes on July 1. We waived the late and high error letters that would normally be sent to those agencies for the July data.

We notified vendors and their agencies of these changes in January 2016. We need your assistance whenever changes are announced to stay in contact with your vendors to ensure that changes are programmed and tested with TBI before the target date. If you know your technical person at the vendor has changed, please notify us just as you would for changes with your agency personnel. This notification will ensure we have the correct contact at your vendor to avoid delays implementing TIBRS changes in the future.

TIBRS Updated Manuals/Forms

The 13th edition of the TIBRS Data Collection Manual has been posted at http://www.tn.gov/tbi/topic/ tennessee-incident-based-reporting-system-tibrs. The updated TIBRS incident report forms are also available at the same link. The latest version of the error manual is also available. These documents have been revised to reflect the new changes to TIBRS effective on July 1, 2016. Due to budget constraints, TBI will not be able to print any copies for agency distribution this year so please download the manual from the website.

2017 TIBRS Changes

We are aware of changes that will be necessary to TIBRS in 2017. The Tennessee General Assembly amended the crime reporting legislation to include the collection of deaths in custody and arrest related deaths. We try to time our change deployment to summer to avoid the first of the year when agencies are finalizing data for publication. We are mandated to begin collecting this information on January 1, 2017. Since these event occurrences are low, we will begin collecting the data on a form that will be developed and plan to deploy the changes to TIBRS in June or July. We will also be expanding the data currently collected for officer involved shooting to include use of force information. This specification is being developed by the FBI and as soon as we have the information, we will send out the change notification to vendors and agencies using vendor RMS products.

FBI NIBRS Technical Specification 3.0

The FBI released the latest technical specification for NIBRS in late August. It has been posted to the TIBRS portion of the TBI web site. The TIBRS information may be found under the Law Enforcement Resources section link located near the bottom of the home page.
