With the 2021 Data Review just around the corner, Abby would like to remind everyone about the Counting Methodology for TIBRS.

# COUNTING METHODOLOGY

CRIMES AGAINST PERSONS

Crimes Against Persons are those whose victims are always classified as "Individual" or "Law Enforcement Official."

### FOR COUNTING PURPOSES

In this category, one offense is counted for each *victim* involved in the incident.

### COUNTING METHODOLOGY CRIMES AGAINST PROPERTY/SOCIETY

In Crimes Against Property and Crimes Against Society, the offender's objective/intent is to obtain money, property or some other benefit.

#### FOR COUNTING PURPOSES

In these categories, offenses are considered *distinct operations*, so the count will reflect <u>one</u>, regardless of the number of victims.

Th<mark>ere is one exception in Crimes Against Property.</mark> For Motor Vehicle Theft, the number of vehicles is counted.









### FROM THE AUDITORS

#### Burglary, Theft from a Building, and Vandalism

In recent audits, we have encountered reports where one incident is reported with the following combination of offenses:

Burglary and Theft from a Building Burglary and Vandalism

Let's look at Burglary and Theft from a Building first. Burglary includes the element of theft or attempted theft. Therefore, an additional Theft Offense should <u>not</u> be reported (TIBRS Manual, pg. 68).

What about Burglary and Vandalism? Burglary also contains the element of forcibly breaking into a structure. That means, there is the likelihood of causing damage. The offense of Vandalism is reported only when the amount of damage done to the structure is greater than \$1000, or if there is damage above and beyond what was required to enter the structure (TIBRS Manual, pg. 69).
