Although Reporting Agency Coordinator (RAC) Orientation and CrimeInsight/ Theme Oriented Public Site (TOPS) are not mandatory at this time, they will be, beginning in 2019. The class covers several things that we do not have time to discuss in the Introduction to Data Collection class. One of the primary topics discussed in detail in the new class is the TIBRS Audit program. Because of several changes we have made to the program over the past two years, this is very important information for all RACs. We decided that this year we will extend the second day of the conference in an effort to give as many of you as possible the opportunity to take the class now. It is not mandatory for you to take the new class at this year's conference. Again, we just wanted to make it available for those who would like to complete the training now. Next year, the conference will go back to the usual 1 ½ days.

We will be teaching RAC Orientation/CrimeInsight/TOPS in Harriman, Jackson, Nashville and Sevierville later this year and several times in 2019.

best as they make their transition to NIBRS.



TIBRS Auditing TIP

Just a note: Driving on Revoked, Driving on Suspended, No Driver's License, and other traffic offenses are not reportable to TIBRS, even as a Group B. These offenses are available on an individual's driving history.

The *only* traffic related offenses reportable to TIBRS are:

- ⇒ Driving Under the Influence (reported as 90D, Group B)
- ⇒ Hit and Run of a Person is reported as a 90Z, All Other Offenses; however, if the person was intentionally struck, the incident would be reported as Aggravated Assault or Murder, Non-Negligent Manslaughter.
- ⇒ Driving While in Possession of Methamphetamine is reported as a 35A, Drug/Narcotic Violation.

This information is located in the TIBRS Manual 13th ed., page 86. But if you have questions, please do not hesitate to contact a member of the CJIS Support Staff.

TIBRS Training—As a Friendly Reminder

- <u>TIBRS Overview & Report Writing class does not count toward initial or recertification training requirements for Reporting Agency Coordinators (RACs) or Alternate RACs.</u>
- CrimeInsight class does not count toward initial or recertification training requirements for Reporting Agency Coordinators (RACs) or Alternate RACs. However, due to the many advantages of using CrimeInsight, we highly recommend that RACs and Alt. RACs attend the class if at all possible.
- Due to limited seating, <u>TnCOP Software</u> classes are for <u>new users only</u>.
