Minutes

10:00am An introduction for the meeting was given by Larry McGoogin, Assistant Director, TDOT Long

Range Planning Division. Each attendee briefly introduced themselves to the group.

10:05am Vanderbilt University is currently conducting a freight research project, which examines the

role that a Freight Advisory Committee might play in responding to supply chain disruptions. Dr. Mark Abkowitz from Vanderbilt University presented a supply chain disruption scenario workshop for Middle Tennessee, which described the possible impacts that significant flooding in the Nashville area could have. The purpose of this exercise was to gain feedback

from the FAC group and incorporate this data into their research efforts.

11:00am A Tennessee Freight Update was presented by Dan Pallme, Assistant Chief of Environment and Planning / Freight and Logistics Director. This update included information regarding the

IMPROVE ACT, current national freight trends, current Tennessee freight trends, and future

freight trends.

- 11:30am Preston Elliott from RPM/KCI and Max Baker from AECOM presented a summary of the current efforts to update the TDOT Freight Plan. The TDOT Freight Plan is currently being updated to become FAST ACT compliant in a collaborative effort between RPM/KCI, AECOM, FHWA, TDOT, and Tennessee RPOs/MPOs/FACs. A survey was given to the FAC members to help prioritize the weighting of the criteria for the Critical Freight Corridors that will be proposed in the TDOT Freight Plan Update.

- 12:30pm Vehicle Platooning Technology information was presented by Dan Pallme, Assistant Chief of Environment and Planning / Freight and Logistics Director. This included information regarding the State Law for Vehicle Platooning, the required notification process, a description of how Vehicle Platooning functions, and upcoming Vehicle Platooning webpages for the TDOT website.
- 1:00pm Dr. Sabya Mishra from the University of Memphis presented a summary of the current freight research project: SHRP2 Implementation Assistance Program. This research focuses on integrating freight considerations into the highway capacity planning process. This includes engagement of community stakeholders and obtaining performance measures for truck parking, recurring and non-recurring freight corridor reliability, and freight and land use integration.
