



### From the Governor

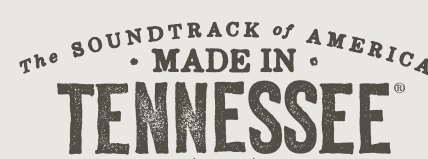
