TennCare is Tennessee's managed care Medicaid program which provides health insurance coverage to certain groups of low-income individuals such as pregnant women, children, parents or caretaker relatives of minor children, older adults, and adults with disabilities.

- Over **1.6 million** Tennesseans are enrolled.
- That's more than **26%** of the state's population.
- TennCare pays for **58% of births** in the state.


★ Through the TennCare III waiver, TennCare received over \$600 million in additional federal dollars, which have been reinvested back into the program.

TennCare's Managed Care Model

TennCare's managed care model means TennCare and CoverKids contract with health insurance plans - also known as managed care organizations or MCOs.

A health plan coordinates care for TennCare members and maintains a network of providers like doctors, hospitals, specialists, pediatricians, and nursing homes.
