Why is the FAFSA so important?

In Tennessee, filing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is a requirement to be eligible for all state aid, including Tennessee Promise and the HOPE Lottery Scholarship.

Through school counselors, TSAC outreach specialists, Advise advisors, TN FAFSA Frenzy, Tennessee Promise partnering organizations, and many others, students in Tennessee get personalized assistance in completing the FAFSA. Research has shown that such support can increase the likelihood that students enroll and persist in college.1
