

## MOA

NVLSP and TDVS executed an MOA in June 2019

- Effective June 21, 2019, to June 20, 2021
  - Court representation continues until case completed at court





### **CAVC REPRESENTATION**

- NVLSP provides pro bono representation at the U.S. Court of Appeals for Veterans Claims (CAVC) to appellants represented by TDVS who were erroneously denied benefits by the BVA
- VA POA stays with TDVS while case at CAVC



## **CAVC REPRESENTATION**

- Initial matters:
  - NVLSP attorneys accredited by TDVS
  - TDVS sends NVLSP list of BVA decisions
  - NVLSP screens decisions to identify BVA errors
  - NVLSP offers pro bono representation
    - Letter to Vet w/ TDVS letter of introduction
    - Copy to TDVS



### **CAVC REPRESENTATION**

- Closing case
  - Closing letter
    - Advice for remand proceedings
  - Copy of JMR / CAVC decision
  - Copy to TDVS
    - Kathryn Held and Travis Murphy



## **BVA REPRESENTATION**

- NVLSP will find pro bono attorney to represent appellant at BVA for <u>some</u> cases <u>remanded by CAVC</u>:
  - BVA likely to make decision without further remand
  - NVLSP-trained/VA-accredited attorney in LSW pro bono network available to provide BVA representation



### **BVA REPRESENTATION**

- NVLSP contacts client for permission
- NVLSP informs TDVS if claimant agrees
- TDVS keeps POA



### **BVA REPRESENTATION**

- Pro bono attorney will
  - Gather lay statements, if necessary/possible
  - Obtain medical opinion, if necessary/possible
  - Draft BVA brief
- NVLSP will mentor pro bono attorney



### **TRAINING & CONSULTATION**

- In-person training to TDVS annually
- 4 free webinars selected by TDVS leadership for up to 35 VSOs

Consultation with senior TDVS officials about legal issues, advocacy strategy, individual VA benefits claims
