


Resources






Resources – Social Isolation

- For many older Tennesseans, social isolation is a complex issue affecting their health status and quality of life.
- Renewed focus to help the state's older adults fight social isolation.
- Programs focused on increasing social connections which are central to the physical, mental, and emotional well-being of older adults.
- Aimed at reducing social isolation and loneliness in older adults

TN Care through Conversation

- Telephone reassurance for ALL older adults and caregivers in Tennessee
- Participants receive a check-in call at least once a week from a volunteer to talk and do a quick needs assessment
