






WHAT IS NVLSP?

Lawyers Serving Warriors – free legal assistance through network of volunteer attorneys:

- Discharge upgrades
- CRSC applications
- Applications to BCMRs for Vets wrongfully discharged for personality disorder or adjustment disorder
- Applications to BCMRs for Vets seeking disability retirement
- Assistance with VA denials of SC for disabilities due to MST
- Applications to the PDBR for an increase in military disability rating to attain a permanent disability retirement
- Representation for svc members being processed through IDES

CAVC REPRESENTATION

 NVLSP provides pro bono representation at the U.S. Court of Appeals for Veterans Claims (CAVC) to appellants represented by TDVS who were erroneously denied benefits by the BVA

•VA POA stays with TDVS while case at CAVC

CAVC REPRESENTATION


NVLSP attorneys are accredited by TDVS

- TDVS identifies TDVS BVA decisions for NVLSP
- NVLSP screens decisions to identify BVA errors
- NVLSP offers pro bono representation to claimant
 - •Letter to client w/ TDVS letter of introduction
 - Copy to TDVS

BVA REPRESENTATION

NVLSP

- NVLSP will find pro bono attorney to assist TDVS at BVA for <u>some</u> cases <u>remanded by</u> <u>CAVC</u>:
 - BVA likely to make decision without further remand
 - Pro bono attorney NVLSP-trained and VAaccredited attorney in LSW pro bono network

BVA REPRESENTATION

- **NVLSP** will contact client for permission
- **NVLSP** will inform TDVS if claimant agrees
- TDVS keeps POA

BVA REPRESENTATION

Pro bono attorney will

Gather lay statements, if necessary/possible

Obtain medical opinion, if necessary/possible

Draft BVA brief

NVLSP will mentor pro bono attorney

BVA REPRESENTATION

- To date, 2 TDVS cases have been placed in this program
 - 1 resulted in BVA granting TDIU for the entire period on appeal
 - 1 resulted in a remand for additional development by the RO
