What is Personal Sensitive Information and BIOMETRIC Information?

- Personal Sensitive Information includes Name, DOB, SS# Address, Drivers License Number, Passport and/or State ID Number.
- Biometric Data is a form of personal information related to biometric characteristics which can be used to identify you. Examples: fingerprints, voiceprints, scans of hand, facial and retina recognition etc.
- What biometric data do they collect? It depends on the services you are trying to access. Many services do not require biometric data. Some of the services that require a higher level of assurance of your identity include the IRS, VA, State unemployment or labor departments, among others.
- How do they use your data?
 - To verify Identity when you open an account or are signing in
 - To authenticate use of your account and the services for a transaction
 - To prevent fraudulent uses of ID.me's Services or the creation of multiple accounts where not prohibited by law.
 - To comply with legal obligations or to comply with a request from law enforcement or government entities
- ID.me does not sell or give away the data
- You may ask for the information to be deleted after verifying your identity.

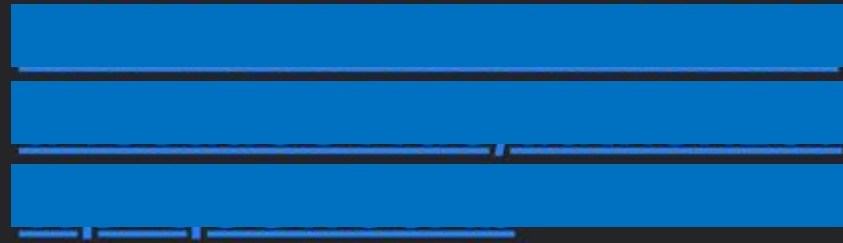

With VA health care, you'll receive coverage for services like regular checkups with your health care provider and specialist appointments.

Disability compensation

With VA disability benefits, you can get disability compensation for an illness or injury that was caused, or made worse, by your military service.

Education and training

With VA education benefits, you and your qualified family members can get help finding a college or training program and paying for tuition or test fees.

What is AccessVA?

AccessVA improves online interaction with the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) for Veterans, family members, service members, and business partners by **providing a single entry point for access to many VA websites and online applications**. AccessVA enables VA websites and online applications to accept a growing number of federal and commercially issued credentials (which meet US Government standards), without the need to create and manage multiple VA website specific credentials.

Increased Convenience and Options

In the past, VA website or online applications required users to provide a username and password for use only on that site. This forced users to maintain many different usernames and passwords for multiple VA websites.

AccessVA allows users to login with Sign-In Partners they may already have such as DS Logon, CAC Card, VA PIV, and more.

Users who do not have one of the Sign-In Partners can register once and gain access to many VA websites, instead of registering for each website individually.

As AccessVA grows, users will have access to even more VA websites. It will also be able to accept more credentials allowing users to choose which is most convenient for them.

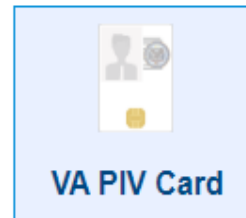

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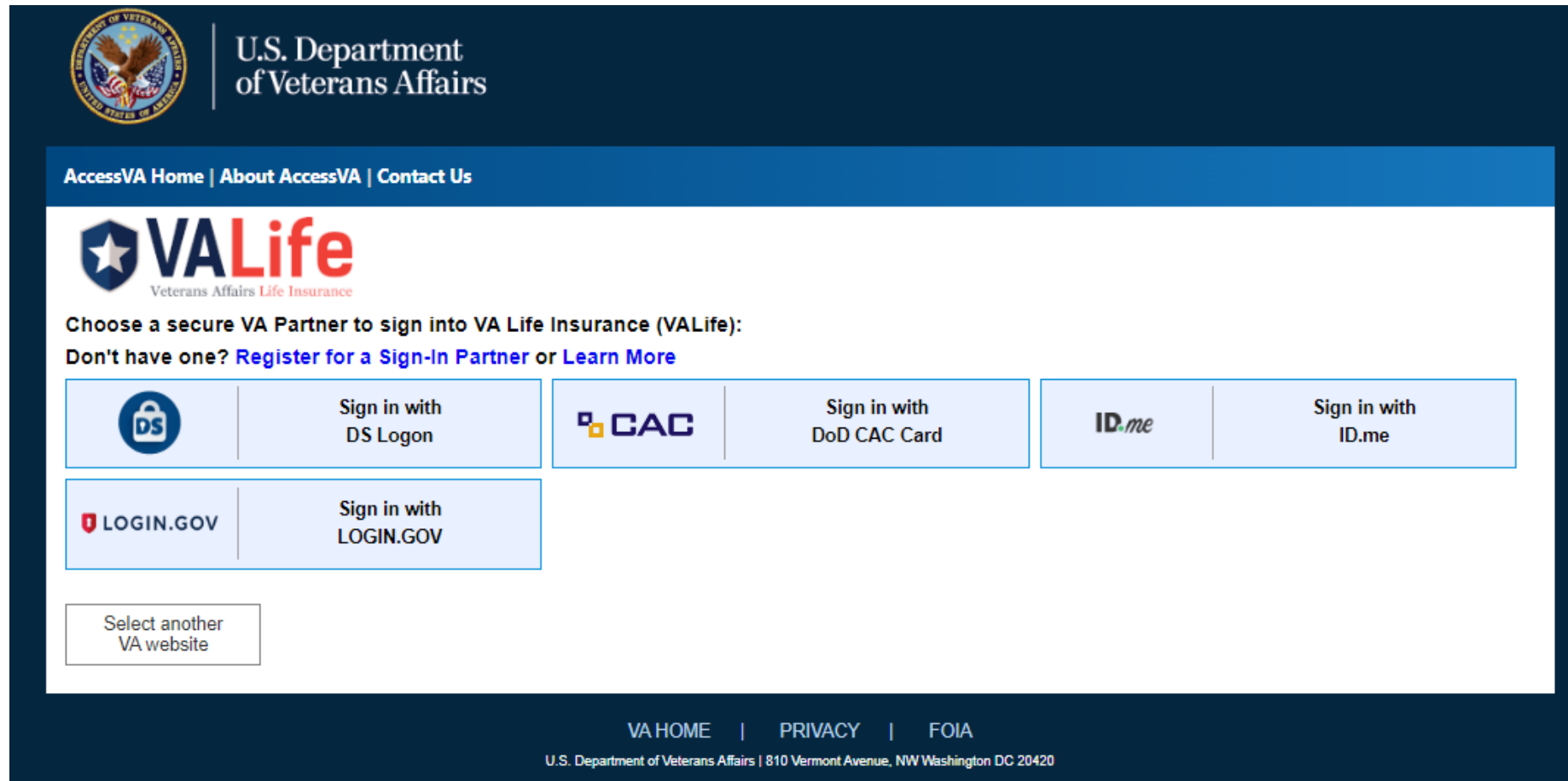
