## PUBLIC NOTICE RULES REMINDER Existing Installations

Pursuant to Rule 0800-3-4-.03 of the official rules of the Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Development, Division of Boiler and Elevator Inspection, Elevator Safety Board, existing elevators are required to meet **ALL** of the requirements of the Safety Code for Existing Elevators and Escalators, ASME A17.3 - 1996, Fourth Edition no later than **April 30, 2007.** 

All automatic elevators having a travel of 70 feet or more must also meet the firefighters' service requirements (Rules 211.3 - 211.8). All modifications to meet these requirements must be operational on or before **April 30, 2007**.

Failure to meet the requirements upon inspection by the Division of Boiler and Elevator Inspection shall subject an installation to possible discontinuance of service.
