But the department received information, received a letter from 23 24 the internal association of amusement parks and attractions that questioned the department's ability to

- attorney general's office asking whether or not that was
- proper. And after learning that Tennessee law did not

> MS.JEFFERSON: As you know, there was no designated funding for the amusement device unit back in or prior to 2016. In July 2016, we received non-

19 recurring funding for fiscal year '16/'17 and '17/'18,

and that was the first time that the amusement device 20

unit received funding. So our request last year -- or 21

22 this past year, rather -- the department submitted a

So it's an excellent tool for us, and we're going to use it going forward to guide
