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## INTRODUCTION

This publication provides statistical information to planners, educators, and employers regarding high school graduates in Tennessee. The data in High School Graduates 2014 are presented in a county summary table followed by statewide totals. Individual county tables are presented alphabetically.

The Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Development, in cooperation with the Tennessee Department of Education, conducts a survey of all schools that have enrollment in grades 9-12 and that qualify to give a state of Tennessee diploma upon graduation. This year, schools were given the opportunity of participate electronically instead of responding by mail. This survey includes all public schools, accredited private schools, and special schools in the state. It excludes home schools, charter schools, and schools with accreditation not recognized by the Department of Education. The following tables list the number of schools and response rates as well as the number of graduates, their educational intentions, and current work plans or military service, if appropriate.

Special thanks are extended to school administrators and counselors who took time to answer this survey. Their cooperation will benefit the educators, employers, and planners across the state who use this publication.

## HIGHLIGHTS

Tennessee's 2013-2014 graduating class attended the state's 408 public and private high schools. There are 21 city high schools, 301 county high schools, 83 private high schools, and three state special schools that constitute the universe of this survey. The special high schools are for the vision and hearing impaired. This year's school breakout was dramatically changed as over 30 Memphis City Schools became part of the Shelby County school system. This survey includes all accredited high schools that had students who qualified for a state of Tennessee diploma. Of the schools that responded to the survey, 75.0 percent of their graduates plan to continue their education.

Private schools graduated only 8.6 percent of all state graduates, but 98.1 percent of these graduates plan to continue their education. City and county schools graduated 91.1 percent of all graduates, but only 72.7 percent of these graduates plan to continue their education. The state special schools account for the remaining 0.3 percent of graduates. The four largest counties (Davidson, Hamilton, Knox, and Shelby) accounted for 33.4 percent of all Tennessee graduates. Graduates from these counties plan to continue their education at a rate of 81.7 percent. The 2014 response rate for these four counties was 78.5 percent, the highest since 2011 when the response rate was 82.1 percent. The response rate in 2013 was 73.3 percent and 78.2 percent in 2012. Schools in the remaining 91 counties, including the special schools, responded at a rate of 86.0 percent with 71.5 percent of graduates planning to continue their education.

The highest percentage of graduates continuing their education in counties with more than two schools responding were Williamson County ( 87.2 percent), Sumner County ( 86.4 percent), Knox County ( 85.2 percent), Shelby County ( 81.8 percent), Davidson County ( 81.6 percent), and Washington County ( 81.0 percent). Counties with a high percentage of graduation and few schools include Clay County ( 89.1 percent), Dyer County ( 86.8 percent), Henderson County ( 86.6 percent), Lincoln County ( 86.1 percent), and Franklin County ( 85.8 percent). The lowest percentages of graduates continuing their education occurred in Stewart County ( 25.3 percent), Hickman County ( 35.0 percent), Hancock County ( 42.3 percent), DeKalb County ( 45.1 percent), and Dickson County ( 46.8 percent). This is the fourth consecutive year that Stewart County had one of the lowest percentages of students continuing their education. There were nine counties that had no schools responding. They were Hardin, Haywood, Houston, Jackson, Lewis, Meigs, Moore, Sequatchie, and White. Haywood and Sequatchie counties had no responses to this survey for the second consecutive year.

An 83.3 percent response rate ( 340 schools) was achieved in this year's high school survey. This was four fewer schools responding as the previous year. The universe decreased by two schools. The figures are not absolute measures; they represent the intentions of the 2013-2014 graduates. All data in this publication are preliminary accounts.

Graduates who did not fit into the categories of continuing their education, entering the labor force, or entering the armed forces were listed in the category of "other." These categories may not add to total graduates because of persons falling into more than one category (i.e., continuing education and entering the labor force).

N/A represents "not applicable" and is used when we did not receive any survey responses for a particular county. Schools that responded to the survey but had no graduates will have zeroes in the data column but will be counted as a responding institution.
