DRIVER'S LICENSE EXAMINER

EXAMINATION METHOD: The examination for Driver's License Examiner consists of a computer administered test. To be eligible for employment consideration an applicant must attain a passing score, 70 or greater, on the test. An applicant's standing or rank on an eligible list is based on this score.

TEST SUMMARY: The test for Driver's License Examiner consists of four computer administered test components. An applicant's standing or rank on an employment register is based on a combination of the four test component scores. The four test components are described below.

Forms Data Entry - This test component requires the use of a computer keyboard to enter information from simulated customer/client application forms. There are 30 application forms to be keyed and 15 minutes are given to accurately key as many of these forms as possible.

Clerical Accuracy - This test component is divided into two sections. The first 17 items measure ability to identify errors in a line of words and numbers. The last 10 items are designed to assess ability to give correct change using simple math operations.

Word Meanings - This test component contains 20 items that have been designed to assess word usage ability.

Driver's License Simulation - This test component contains 52 items designed to assess the ability to apply driver's license requirements to given interactions with hypothetical driver's license applicants.
